

Re: Public Awareness / Quarterly Issues

In the period from January 1, 2020, through March 31, 2020, radio stations KJTH/KZTH/KXTH/KTHL/KIXO/KTHM/KTHF addressed several issues of public concern. Numerous public service announcements were made on behalf of various local non-profit organizations and churches. In the month of January, we had a contest called the "30 day challenge" where listeners had the opportunity to listen to The House FM for 30 days to see if the on-air encouragement from our DJ's and positive music changed their lives. We also started a new monthly contest for listeners called the House Call Box. Each month we draw a new winner and giveaway special gifts picked out by our staff. The House FM also continued and partnered with Mardel, a Christian and Education Store, for our monthly on-air Teacher Appreciation Contest where listeners nominate their favorite broadcast-area teacher for a chance to win a goody basket full of supplies for his/her classroom and a \$100 Mardel gift card. In February, our DJ's and Promotions Team attended and interacted with listeners at the Hits Deep Oklahoma City Concert, Oklahoma City's Winter Jam and Wichita's Winter Jam. Towards the end of February, we kicked off our annual Spring Fundraiser to raise the funds necessary to meet our 2020 non-profit budget. Listeners had the opportunity to win gift prizes and other special on-air prizes, like concert tickets. In March, we had a social media contest called "Music of March" where listeners went to our facebook page and voted for their favorite band. There were 32 Christian bands listed to vote for and listeners took advantage of this contest. We had over 9,000 votes for this contest. A randomly selected winner won a merchandise pack from their favorite band. The House FM also passed along public information on severe and inclement weather. And, on the attached sheets, other issues are listed which were broadcast on the program "Focus on the Family". "Focus on the Family" airs each weekday from 5-5:30am.
