Re: Public Awareness/Quarterly issues

In the period from October 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016, KJTH/KXTH/KZTH/KTHF/KTHL addressed the following issues of concern. On October 22, over 675 kids, and around 1380 people total, came to the radio station to be a part of Kid DJ Day. Games, face painting, a petting zoo, a balloon toss and more all took place outside at the station. Inside, the kids were able to take a station tour, talk on the radio, and see Val Castor, a local Storm Chaser for Channel 9 in OKC. In November, we collected 321 turkeys in Enid, Wichita, Ponca City, Stillwater, Bartlesville, Arkansas City, Oklahoma City, Shawnee, Lawton, and Altus. These turkeys were then given to the Salvation Army in each community, and used to feed local families a Thanksgiving meal. In December, we were part of the Christmas paraded in Stillwater, Arkansas City, and Ponca City. Numerous public service announcements were made on behalf of various local non-profit organizations and churches. We also passed along public information on severe weather and inclement weather. We broadcast "Focus On The Family" each weekday morning between 5:30 and 6:00 and they cover issues of concern for today's families. The station also hosted some tours from homeschool students, church groups, and scouting groups.
