Topics discussed in the 2nd Quarter include...

- The Dade County budget was discussed and passed, just over \$10.8 million.
- Several paving projects were discussed and are underway with summer approaching. The repair of County Rd. 6 was discussed and \$175k has already been invested
- The Public Relations position was filled the first week of June by Carey Faucett. Her title is Deputy County Clerk assisting Don Townsend.
- Georgia Drives was set in place for the tag operations system for the state of Georgia. The commissions office was closed so training and installation of the program could take place.
- Current cost of living was discussed. Commissioner Rumley advised that Dade County does follow state guidelines.
- A 2% raise was set for all county employees. This effects 142 employees of Dade County.
