Quarterly Issues and Programs WSOU FM South Orange, NJ Third Quarter July 1 to Sept. 30

Issue: The ruling by the US Supreme Court to overturn the Roe vs Wade decision to legalize abortion. The result has been concern across the country and the response by the public. Some states have imposed strict restrictions as a result, even making abortion a crime. It has also made it difficult for many women to get an abortion. This has become a crisis.

Programming: A number of programs on WSOU have covered the issue both locally and on a national level. Pirate Nes Desk has interviewed state officials to see the reaction in New Jersey. On a national level the topic has become regular coverage. The program Making Contact has discussed the impact on women, especially in states where the restrictions are stifling. The coverage has also dealt with states which have decided to help women get an abortion.

Quarterly Issues and Programs WSOU FM South Orange, NJ Third Quarter July 1 to Sept. 30

Issue: The summer saw a number of violent terrorist attacks in the country. Children were slaughtered in Uvalde Texas and there were a number of individual attacks, many which were racially motivated.

Programming: This issue was covered by the station across all types of programs. The Pirate News Desk show discussed the problem on a number of episodes. Making Contact also discussed the effects on a national level. However shows such as Knightly Message and Thank God for Monday also addressed the issue. Those discussions dealt with the psychological effects on families and children. They also talked about the culture of caring for one another as a society.

Quarterly Issues and Programs WSOU FM South Orange, NJ Third Quarter July 1 to Sept. 30

Issue: The post covid pandemic and concern about MonkeyPox. Society has made a substantial Step towards normalcy. There continues to be a limited mask mandate and new booster vaccines. At the same time there has been a concern over the growing impact of MonkeyPox.

Programming: Pirate News Desk has reported regularly on the return to regular life with a real limit on restrictions. Also daily newscasts covered the issue. They include extended interviews with the medical community to get a better understanding of the issue. The station has also

made itself a source of information for people who need help. WSOU runs regular Public Service Announcements with tips and guidance help.

Issue: Workplace issues have changed in recent years, compounded by the covid crisis. People are returning to the workplace in person while many people are hoping to remain long distance emplyees. This has created all kinds of issues for employers and employees.
