I.	Consumer/Economy	High interest rates, high rate of poverty among minorities and women who are heads of households, hunger, the homeless, federal state and local government spending, and the need for consumer education
II.	Crime	Increase in youth delinquency, vandalism, drug abuse, domestic and child abuse, neighborhood watch programs, court reform and judicious sentencing, crimes against senior citizens, security of prison and county facilities, prostitution, gang violence and hate crimes.
III.	Education	Teacher/parent involvement, student motivation, funding cutbacks, declining quality of education, increase of classroom sizes, and education for minorities

Increase of liquor stores in black communities, integration of ethnic cultures into the arts. Hispanic language and economic barriers, disenfranchised minority youth within the education system.
VII.	Urban Interests	Increase homeless population, public transportation system, congested traffic systems, affordable housing, and zoning issues.
VIII.	Job Market	Unemployment, apprenticeship programs, affirmative action, and training programs, recession psychological affects, non-hiring in the private sector, job loss in major industries and pay equality.
IX.	Social Matters	Social and Community concerns with women's rights, racial equality, and community outreach to the homeless and less fortunate.
X.	Environmental	Disposal of industrial waste, cleaning up Santa Monica bay, air pollution, cost of energy and other utilities, endangered species, desert parks, and education on water conservation.
