For 30 years, Warrenton Virginia based Rainforest Trust has worked to preserve the world's most endangered species from extinction. On November 8th, the Trust will launch largest ever public auction of species naming rights. Holiday shoppers will be able to buy the gift of naming one of 12 new species recently discovered in nature reserves the Trust and its partners established in South America. These new-to-science species include a blue-eyed yellow frog, speckled red and green frogs, orchids, a trap jaw ant, a forest mouse, a worm-like caecilian, and a big-eyed red salamander. Bidding ends on December 8th at a private event in Washington, DC (bids also accepted by phone and online). All proceeds directly protect the habitat of the specific plant or critter, helping save them from extinction.

Power to Decide is a private, non-partisan, non-profit organization that works to ensure all people, no matter who they are, where they live, or what their economic status might be, have the power to decide if, when, and under what circumstances to get pregnant and have a child. The organization has conducted surveys on the lines of political views, as well as social and economic backgrounds. Nearly 8 in 10 (78%) adults in the United States—including 66% of Republicans and 93% of Democrats—consider birth control to be a basic part of women's health care, according to a new telephone survey of more than 1,000 adults 18 and older being released by Power to decide.

A recent clinical study by Cornell University Veterinary School and ElleVet Sciences shows that 80% of the dogs given their hemp oil blend saw significant or dramatic improvement in pain levels and quality of life. The study showed the hemp oil blend is “efficacious for pain in dogs with osteoarthritis, chronic joint pain and geriatric pain and soreness.”

The book vividly illustrates the constitutional balancing act where medicine, family interests, and child safety can clash, in a narrative told by the family’s lawyer (Diane Redleaf). Sadly, the cases the book tells in dramatic detail are not anomalies but part and parcel of a foster care system that every month separates children at 300 times the rate of the separations at the southern border in May 2018.
