

WTKY AM PUBLIC ISSUES FOR 4TH QUARTER 2017

We at WTKY AM take our public service programming seriously. We interview a variety of guests that are involved, and make up our community. We air our program each Monday morning from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. We rebroadcast that same program each Monday evening from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. for the listeners that may have missed the morning broadcast.

In addition to the highlighted guests listed below, we have additional guests on the program that might have information not as critical as our main guests, but community information, just the same. Such additional guests include quilting clubs, art clubs, athletic hall of fame, and much, much, more.

We also have our Community Calendar that airs Monday through Saturday, sometime between 8:00 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. The length of the program varies because the items listed are brief, and added and deleted daily.

10.09.17 Guest Brandy Adams from the library discusses local kids' programs going on at the library, including the two-day Storytime program, which services kids preschool and younger. There is also a Trunk-or-Treat planned at the library, and it'll be in the parking lot. The library will also be opened with activities. Registration will be on the book mobile (25 minutes). Guest Kevin Lines, County Extension Agent, discusses the upcoming field day, which includes industrial hemp demonstrations, and 4H will be there. It includes all departments from the Extension. Also discussed is crop insurance. (25 minutes).

10.23.17 Dallas Carenhand and Carolyn Emeritt discuss the backpack program for local school children and what an important service it provides. Also discussed are the sponsors of the program, how to become one, and how people can apply their child to get a backpack. (20 minutes) Susan Clarkston discusses relay for life (fundraiser for American Cancer Society), discusses history and purpose. (15 minutes) Sharon Walker and Mayor Scotty Turner discuss upcoming Halloween event at the Justice Center and Courthouse including costume contest, hot dogs, pie contest. (20 minutes)

11.06.17 Overview of the Halloween event and how successful it was. Guest Sheila Rush discusses events coming up at the Old Mulkey Meeting House, including the founders' reenactment coming up this month. Also discussed is the historical societies' drive for old Tompkinsville memorabilia, including old telephone books and advertisement from local businesses. Also discussed is the upcoming quilt show, quilt show winners of the past, and how to enter. (50 minutes)

11.13.17 Kerry Denton from the local police department discussing the Stuff the Cruise and Shop with a Cop and other police sponsored philanthropic events, and how the community can get involved with the giving and who is eligible to be a beneficiary for the program. Also discussed Turkey the Town at the Farmer's Market for people who do not have their own Thanksgiving meal, along with other dinner events for Thanksgiving (30 minutes). Also a

discussion of other upcoming local events, as well as agricultural tips to prepare for the winter (15 minutes).

12.04.17 Deborah Arnish discusses the upcoming Christmas Blessing that will be happening for the first this year. It will be held at the National Guard Armory on December 24. Also discussed is how to get involved and the dinner menu. (20 minutes) Tim Johnson discusses local agriculture, and the local fauna in the winter months. Also discussed is the importance of covering plants in your personal garden during the cold weather, and how it works. (25 minutes)

12.11.17 Mayor Scotty Turner discusses the November meeting of the city commission, including all the supervisor updates and public comment. Also discussed is the treasurer's report, and the fiscal state of the city and county. Also discussed are outstanding grants, including those related to the small business improvements on Main Street. Also discusses holiday schedules for trash collection and city building closures due to the holidays (45 minutes).
