Colorado Springs homeowners clean up after "catastrophic" hail storm - Insurance companies say they've seen so much damage, they are now calling it a catastrophic weather event. "Anytime that there's a significant number of claims like this, it will reach a threshold between a storm and the number of claims in a given area in which we categorize a catastrophe," Rich Johnson, a spokesman for USAA said. "It just sounded like literally someone was throwing baseballs at my house!" Sharon Navarrette said. That's why USAA has deployed its Catastrophe Response Team in the JCPenny parking lot off of Powers. The last time they needed this type of response in Colorado Springs was after nearly 500 homes were destroyed in the Black Forest Fire three summers ago.
