Pursuant to Section 325 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended and Section 76.64 of the FCC rules, this is to notify you that **WBFS-TV, MIAMI** ("Station"), assigned to the MIAMI-FT. LAUDERDALE market ("DMA"), elects the retransmission consent option with respect to carriage of Station's signal on your cable system whose head-end is located in **PEMBROKE FALLS, FL** and any other cable systems that you own, operate, or control that serve communities in the DMA for the 2015-2017 election period.


