If no agreement is in effect beyond December 31, 2014, then it will be necessary for your system to obtain our express, prior, and written consent in order to retransmit **WBFS-TV's** signal after 12:01 AM on January 1, 2015 (or, if earlier, after the expiration date of any existing agreement).

For purposes of clarification, this election letter does not authorize your cable system(s) or other video distribution system(s) to retransmit the signal of the Station in any manner.
