Discussion of Student Addiction Issues at Holbrook SDA Indian Boarding School

We ran the following program to address above issue from:

Celebrating Life In Recovery

Brief Description of Program: (Format, participants, content, etc.): Host Cherie Peters interviewed Principal Janet and her husband Heff from the Holbrook SDA Indian Boarding School in Arizona. Recovery is different depending on what level you are at in your recovery. Early recovery is different than middle recovery or later recovery and it also makes a difference as to your addiction. Today's guests Lorenzo (anger issues), Amber (cutting issues), Manual and Crystal (smoking and drinking issues) all came from very dysfunctional families so the kids ended up living and being cared for by grandparents. Janet and Heff resided over these kids but they let them know that they both also had prior addiction problems. The kids learned that addiction problems was not what God wanted His children to be involved in but to work at getting and maintaining a healthy lifestyle. These kids are working very hard to achieve and maintain this new lifestyle.

Brief Description of Program: (Format, participants, content, etc.): Host Dr. David DeRose interviewed Eric Flickenger who was originally part of NETA – New England Evangelistic Training School who's main purpose was to assist people to find their purpose in their own lives. One way to accomplish this is to share the Gospel and Health Tips that are written in the scriptures. His wife is a Registered Dietitian with a Masters Degree in Food Science and Nutrition. She assists in helping the patients that are critically ill and does a Health Nugget at her husband's preachings. They both are there to help the Native American Indian with Health Issues but this work also opens up a line of communication to share the Bible and God's Love for them.

Brief Description of Program: (Format, participants, content, etc.): Host Steve Moore interviewed guest host Rob West who is the President of Kingdom Advisers and Associates. His company provides an advocacy, training and community for financial professionals who are specialist in offering biblical wise advice to clients. **Credit Card Tips** are always proceed with cautions when using a credit card, but the advantages of credit card usage are #1. You receive points that grant cash, travel or shopping rewards. #2. Purchases are protected after the first \$50 so if your card is stolen & used, you would not be responsible for charges over \$50. #3. Perk Benefits are granted on purchases such as extended warranties, car rental insurance, etc and #4. You will build up your credit if you carry a small balance and make your payments on time which will be an asset when you go to purchase a new home or in seeking employment. **Debit Card Advantages** are #1. Less debt risk, #2. You will achieve discipline as you will spend within your needs, #3. No fees encountered, #4 Cash is usually free. **Some Cash Pros & Cons** are #1.
