Below is a listing of some of the issues and/or problems that we have become aware of during this past quarter and a description of some of the programs that we aired to address these issues.

FAITH IN ACTION (FIA) is a locally produced 28 minute program. It is co-hosted by station manager Jim Ganley and Brigid Ayer. Each program features one or more in-studio guests (or by phone) and addresses a particular issue. Each week, two different programs are produced and aired. Each program is broadcast three times during the specific week indicated. Some of the programs and their topics are listed below. The programs are aired every week on the following schedule:

<u>Schedule A</u> Monday 12:00 PM, Thursday 4 PM, and Saturday at noon. <u>Schedule B</u> Monday 4 PM, Friday 12:00 PM, and Saturday at 12:30 PM

Helping Older adults and those with disabilities to stay in their homes

Three times during the week of Sept 27 – Oct 2, FIA (Schedule A) featured an interview with Tauhric Brown, President & CEO of Central Indiana Council on Aging in Indianapolis. Their program will give older citizens and those with disabilities a way to stay in their homes with private and government assistance.

Corrections Ministry Conference 2021

This is a program about the spiritual wellbeing of those that are currently incarcerated. Deacon Marc Kellams, Coordinator of the Corrections Ministry with the Archdiocese of Indianapolis, was interviewed. Three times during the week of Sept 20 – Sept 25, FIA (Schedule B) featured representatives from these organizations talking about programs that they offer to help resolve this issue.

Constitutional Rights in a Post-Pandemic Era

Three times during the Week of Sept 27 – Oct 2nd, FIA (Schedule A) featured an interview with nationally known attorney, James Bopp. He spoke and was interviewed on personal liberty and constitutional rights as they relate to issues surrounding current pandemic issues.

Food Rescue Fostering Good Stewardship

Much food that would otherwise be thrown away or discarded, can be rescued and put to good use in area food pantries. Three times during the week of Aug 30th – Sept 4th, FIA (Schedule B), featured information about this topic from John Williamson, Executive Director of Food Rescue.

Post Covid Stress and Self Care

Three times during the week of Aug 2 – 7th, FIA (Schedule B) featured and interview with Rachael Smith, a Mental Health Counselor with Secure Foundations. She was interviewed regarding the stress that has accompanied the pandemic for the past year and a half, and which continues to the present day.

Renewal for the Parish in the Hispanic Community

Three times during the week of Sept 13 – 18th, FIA (Schedule B) featured in interview with Oscar Castellanos, Director for Initiative for Parish Renewal "Renovacion". This program addresses the rise in the Hispanic community and how to be 'inclusive' in areas of church leadership.
