Description: Birth announcements as received from local hospitals and as received From local citizens listed on birth forms as provided by the local hospitals.

Program/Date/Time/Length: airtime/3-7-15 and 3-14-15 Each Saturday/12p-4:30p 4hr-30min.
Description: Live broadcast originating in downtown Dodgeville of charity auction. Bids taken by telephone, items announced on air, winning bidders announced, and General info about Dodgeville Kiwanis activities aired. All funds to club. \$10,122.00 total dollars raised for Community projects for 2 day event. Auction originating at the Dodgeville chamber of commerce office in Dodgeville.
