

RESPONSE OF ENTRAVISION HOLDINGS, LLC
TO LETTER OF INQUIRY, DATED MARCH 12, 2013

Entravision Holdings, LLC ("Entravision") has prepared and is submitting this Response to a Letter of Inquiry issued to Entravision by the Media Bureau of the Federal Communications Commission, on March 12, 2013. As Entravision has previously informed the staff of the Media Bureau, the March 12 letter, addressed to Entravision's headquarters, was not immediately determined to be a matter of importance. Rather than routing it immediately to management, the letter was routed internally until it was recognized as an item to be immediately dealt with. At that point, Entravision immediately informed the Commission that it was not ignoring the LOI and is providing this response pursuant to a scheduling understanding with the Media Bureau staff.

Entravision wishes to inform the Commission that it has taken the following actions in regard to the on-line public inspection file (the "File") for Station KVER-CA, Indio, California (FIN: 69753):

1. On April 5, 2013, the File was updated to reflect the main studio location for the Station.
2. The licensee has uploaded to the File its issues/programming lists for the period from 2007 to and including, the first quarter of calendar year 2013.
3. The licensee has uploaded to its File Statements evidencing its compliance, since 2000, with the eligibility requirements for Class A Stations, as provided for in Sections 73.6001 and 73.3526(e)(17) of the Commission's Rules.

DECLARATION OF JEFFERY A. LIBERMAN


I, Jeffery A. Liberman, do hereby declare as follows:
