The Investigations and Hearings Division of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) recently completed its review of the response of New Hampshire Public Radio, Incorporated, licensee of WEVC(FM), Gorham, NH, (Fac ID No. 24235), and the other above-referenced stations in the employment unit, to the February 25, 2021 random audit issued in accordance with the provisions of 47 C.F.R. § 73.2080(f)(4) of the FCC's Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) rules. As a result of our review, we find that no further action is required.
