Libous was accused of using his political influence to get his son a job - and secure his salary - with a law firm in Westchester County. A key witness for the prosecution claimed the deal was worked out over dinner & that Libous promised to steer business to the firm in exchange for hiring his son. Libous faces up to 5 years in prison & will lose his Senate seat.

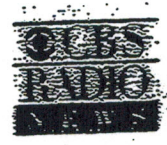

Discussions: The Owego Fire Department presented to the public a proposal for the department to run as an independent district, if selected officials approve the referendum and voters also approve the proposal. Owego Fire Chief Dan Garvin said the proposal is a way to deal with pending financial problems in the future if the fire dept remains funded by the village budget. The big difference in budgeting would be collecting taxes on property owners to set aside a reserve fund for trucks & ambulances rather than bonding. A vote may happen in March 2016 & if approved, the independent district will be a reality in Sept. 2016.
