billion contract to build a new fleet of combat rescue

Owego will handle the new fleet's modernized mission
systems. The project has a potential value close to \$8 billion.
This is the latest in a string of developments for Lockheed w/ construction

the company is also transitioning jobs from Akron, OH to Owego.
