- 1) During the course of WBXF's license renewal process and based on communications with Federal Communications Commission ("Commission") staff, it was discovered that WBXF's quarterly Children's Programming Commercial Time Limitation Certifications going back to the station's previous license renewal did not contain the signature of a station employee.
- 2) This supplement covers quarterly Children's Programming Commercial Time Limit Certifications for 2022.
- 3) 3)In addition, the covered certifications mistakenly reference Section 73.760 of the Commission's rules. Notwithstanding that typo, the quarterly Children's Programming Commercial Time Limit Certifications in WBXF's online public inspection file were intended to and do address compliance with Section 73.670 of the Commission's rules.
- 4) 4)All children's television programming aired by the WBXF-CD during the time period covered by this supplemental certification complied with the limits on commercial material aired during children's programming under Section 73.670 of the Commission's rules, including programming broadcast on both weekdays and weekend.
