United States Department of Agriculture PSA

The Farm Service Agency is now accepting applications for Emergency farm loans due to Hurricane Harvey occurring from August 23, 2017 and continuing. Wharton County Farm Loan Manager, Gail Hoskins, asks farmers who want to apply for emergency loans to submit their applications as soon as possible to the Matagorda county FSA office located at 1006 Avenue F Suite A2 in Bay City which is where the Wharton County FSA Farm loan staff is currently located. The deadline to submit an application is April 25, 2018, but Hoskins says if farmers wait too long, a backlog will develop and cause delays. Generally, farmers who have lost 30% of their production or any physical loss due to hurricane Harvey on August 23, 2017 and thereafter, are eligible for the emergency loan.
