7/2/23	Military spending is up around the world. Will they protect fossil fuel interests while the world burns? Australia security analyst & climate researcher Dr. Elizabeth Boulton has a very different plan. Canadian medical doctor Peter Carter now heads the Climate Emergency Institute. Carter says the world climate is already tipping into disaster.
7/9/23	Just as we feared, new science confirms tipping points and climate catastrophes can arrive much, much sooner than we were told. A must-listen interview with UK research scientist and lead author Simon Willcock . Seems like it's already here, with extreme heat punishing every continent. Canadian scientist Paul Beckwith joins me to peer through the smoke into the climate fire, around the planet.
7/16/23	Israeli historian, author & scholar Yuval Noah Harari blows our minds, going beyond human with artificial intelligence. How long before it surpasses us, evolving beyond control – and takes over? What then? Selections from from the Frontiers Forum April 2023, and Jordan Harbinger podcast June 2023.
7/23/23	The first global heat wave , across the Northern Hemisphere, land and sea, just happened in July 2023. After the hottest June ever, we burned through four days with the hottest global temperature recorded by humans on this planet. After a fast review of world news on heat and floods, Alex replays interviews with Princeton's Jane Baldwin ("Back-to-Back Heatwaves") and Canadian scientist Merritt Turetsky ("Abrupt Permafrost Thaw").

7/30/23	UK, Professor Tim Jackson on his book “Post Growth: Life After Capitalism”. Lorenz Keysser from ETH Zurich takes it further: planned decline coupled with increasing well-being – degrowth. Stock markets, banks, every business – everybody wants to grow more and buy, buy, buy. Will we wait for the great collapse, or plan our way back down the mountain?
8/6/23	As world heat records fall, on land and sea, best-selling author Jeff Goodell on his book: “The Heat Will Kill You First”. Greenland is hot and extra rainy, dumping more water into the sea. Glaciologist Jason Box reports. But Greenland was partly ice-free just 400,000 years ago – what a new study warns us about today. Lead author Andrew Christ is our guest.
8/13/23	Are you ready for real disaster news? If the warming currents in the North Atlantic weaken or collapse, Ireland, England, and North Europe will become stormy and cold, even as the world warms. A collapse of the ocean system known as “AMOC” has happened before. New study: destabilization could come again soon, even this decade. Hear it straight from author Susanne Ditlevsen , followed by analysis, including by Stefan Rahmstorf .
8/20/23	With world heat records this summer – is too late? Should we just give up and party like there’s no tomorrow? Scientist James Lovelock , inventor of Gaia, says “yes”. Former NASA scientist James Hansen says “no”. Loaded with clips including Obama’s science man John Holdren , deep greener Derrick Jensen , country singer Katty Mattea , late rocker Tom Petty , Lovelock on “Vanishing Gaia” and Hansen arrest audio (with Daryl Hannah) in this Ecoshock blast from the past.

9/3/23	With more extreme wildfires, atmospheric scientist Peter Bernath on fires and ozone damage; UNEP report: “Spreading Like Wildfire” with Dr. Andrew Sullivan of CSIRO, Australia. 9/10/23	Did we just enter a new climate? Recent heat, rains, and violent storms struck around the world. Meteorologist & storm-chaser Bob Henson covers extreme weather for you. As big
