WGRN airs two public service announcements every hour, for organizations such as AARP, Adopt US Kids, the American Stroke Association, Autism Speaks, the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention, Feeding America, the Federal Emergency Management Agency, Grads of Life, Keep America Beautiful, the Literacy Foundation, Meals on Wheels, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, the National Resources Defense Council, TEACH (US Department of Education), Understood, the US Forest Service, and the US Department of Health and Human Services. Public service announcements are also made for local organizations such as the Simple Room, the Greenville Free Methodist Church, St. Lawrence Catholic Church, the First Baptist Church, Mothers of Preschoolers, and the Lemuel Rhodes Cancer Foundation. PSAs highlight topics such as volunteering, adoption, public health and safety, youth services, driving safety, and the environment.
