<p>Rule delay makes big EV tax credit possible early next year</p>	<p>SRN News Reports: People who want to buy an electric vehicle could get a bigger-than-expected tax credit come January first. The Inflation Reduction Act calls for the batteries' minerals and parts to also come from North America or a country with a U.S. free-trade agreement, but that provision is now on hold. That's because of a delay by the Treasury Department in drawing up rules for the tax breaks. The department says it won't finish the rules that govern where battery minerals and parts have to be sourced until sometime in March.
