

Title Reaching Across Cultural Divides I-II  
Length 26 minutes  
Description Racial disharmony is tearing communities apart, both inside and outside the Church. But Jesus is the great reconciler, and we too are called by God to build bridges, cross cultural lines, and model diversity in every area of our lives. Dr. David Ireland, pastor of a multi-ethnic church and diversity consultant to the NBA, shares stories from his own life about how he was persecuted and how God redeemed that to give him a heart for reconciliation. He also shares stories from his church about formerly racist people forgiving each other, and he talks about how prejudice within the church is not always about race. He explains how to allow personal change and let go of prejudice, how to have healthy cross-cultural friendships and how to facilitate authentic reconciliation.
