Flores secured 24% of the votes, gaining his spot in the runoff over Urrutia, who garnered about 23.6% of the votes. The runoff is May 28.

Supreme Court Justice Samuel Alito extended the pause on Texas' SB4 law indefinitely while the court evaluates it and ultimately decides if it can go into effect or not. Alito's order said it is "extended pending further order" by the court. The law was first blocked by a federal court, which was overturned on appeal. The Biden administration filed an appeal on March 4, bringing the case to the Supreme Court.
