

Pursuant to 47 United States Code Section 535(b)(1) and Section 76.56 of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission, WHYY is requesting carriage of Station WHYY, Philadelphia, PA, which is a qualified local noncommercial television station entitled to carriage on your cable television system(s) located at Easton, PA, Lehigh Valley, PA and Emmaus, PA (as well as continuing carriage on the Service Electric systems on which it is already carried.)

As we discussed and agreed, Service Electric will now put WHYY's main channel on Service Electric's Channel 21, and within 60 days Service Electric will put WHYY's Arts & Culture digital multicast channel on in the neighborhood of Service Electric's channels 120 to 132. 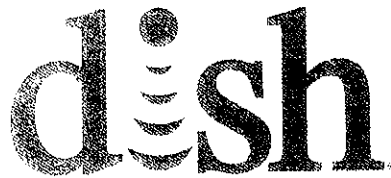

Dear WHYY, INC.:

By this letter, DISH Network L.L.C. ("DISH") provides notice of its intent to commence local-into-local service for ATSC digital signals that are broadcast in ATSC high-definition ("HDTV") format pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 338 and the amended rules of 47 C.F.R. § 76.66, in the Philadelphia DMA on or before February 17, 2013. This letter is intended only to provide the notification required by 47 C.F.R. § 76.66(d)(2)(vi) of DISH's designation of the Philadelphia DMA as a HD carry one, carry all market pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 76.66(k)(2).

Consequently, so long as your station has either made a valid election of mandatory carriage or negotiated a grant of retransmission consent for its HDTV signal pursuant to applicable federal laws, rules, and regulations and, provided that your station has delivered a good quality HDTV signal in accordance with the attached Appendix to the DISH local receive facility at the address set forth below, you will be entitled to carriage by DISH of your station's HDTV signal by February 17, 2013.

APPENDIX: MINIMUM ENGINEERING AND TECHNICAL PARAMETERS FOR CARRIAGE OF HIGH DEFINITION DIGITAL SIGNALS

1. A good quality signal of your HDTV Channel should be delivered as soon as practicable (and no later than January 1, 2013) to DISH's Local Receive Facility to prepare for retransmission by February 17, 2013. The exact date on which the carriage of your station in HD has not yet been determined and will, in part, depend on the dates on which good quality signals are delivered to DISH's Local Receive Facility. You are encouraged to notify us of your intent to deliver an HD signal as soon as possible to better allow us to prepare for the carriage of your signal and launch the channel as soon as feasible.
2. No later than January 1, 2013, please complete and return the attached tech sheet.
3. All HDTV Channels are subject to the federal requirements that prohibit substantial duplication of programming.
4. All HDTV Channels must comply with any and all federal, local, and state EAS requirements and other requirements as set forth under relevant laws, rules and regulations.
5. All HDTV Channels must also comply with closed-captioning requirements, and closed captioning information shall be delivered to DISH Network in native 708 format.
6. Definitions:
 - a. A Programming Feed is the video and audio transmitted simultaneously as a single "channel" of programming.
 - b. The "HDTV Channel" shall mean the single Programming Feed contained in a Station's ATSC digital signal, broadcast with content on a 24X7 basis in ATSC high-definition ("HDTV") format and is designated by the Station as its "primary channel" consistent with FCC requirements. Each broadcaster is permitted only one HDTV Channel.


