FORT WORTH'S FOURTH




For the fourth year, our stations co-sponsored Fort Worth's community celebration at the Panther Island Pavilion. The event benefits the care of the city's Trinity River.

Weather and Amber Alerts

KDFI Channel 27 participated as a full partner with the broadcast community in broadcasting emergency information to the market, including Amber Alert and Severe Weather Warnings. Whether it be dangerous lightning, school closings or tornado warnings, KDFI Channel 27 provided timely communications to viewers. Our weather during the 3rd quarter was quiet for the most part, and KDFI Channel 27 alerted our viewers to make them aware when it was warranted.

“Animal Rescue” showcases spectacular rescues of all types of animals and focuses on the work of dedicated individuals who treat various creatures in the animal kingdom.

“Xploration: DIY Science” works toward the goal to inspire kids to become interested in STEM (science, technology, engineering and math), and ultimately pursue careers in these fields.

Each morning, Andrew Wommack teaches the ways of the Bible and how to use the tools given to better our everyday lives.

A non-denominational Bible teaching program in the spirit of tolerance and good will toward all.
