Ascertainment of Issues

KDFI Channel 27 provides information, education and communication resources to its viewers. The station works with the community to address issues and concerns raised by our viewers through their letters, emails and phone calls. We collect all correspondence as well as respond to phone calls in an effort to ensure we are providing the best service to viewers in our community.

KDFI Channel 27 sponsors community events and is involved with the lives of our viewers. We notify our audience of neighborhood events and other public happenings through airing numerous PSA's during the quarter to educate and inform the public (a list of PSA's and sponsorships that aired is below).

SEVERE WEATHER AWARENESS DAY

Since 2016, the FOX 4 Weather team has presented a seminar on Severe weather onsite at Nebraska Furniture Mart. We worked with the Mart to bring it back with all safety protocols in place. Our meteorologists answer questions and deliver lifesaving information. In addition, we had a greenscreen set up for kids (and adults) to try their hand at forecasting the weather.



MAYFEST AT HOME

Covid protocols prevented the return of the annual four-day outdoor festival to return in 2021, but we worked with the organizers on a series of online (and on-air) vignettes on how to recreate popular activities (such as confetti eggs) at home, along with reminders the festival will be returning May 2022.



HERE'S TO YOU

FOX News Anchor Clarice Tinsley highlights organizations and individuals who are making a difference in their community. “Here’s To You” airs twice daily during FOX 4’s 5:30 and 10pm newscasts. During the monthly of May and part of June, we saluted dozens of graduates, faculty, and staff of the Class of 2021 for their resiliency in navigating an unprecedented school year.



MAYOR’S SUMMER READING PROGRAM

Libraries reopened in Late May, and for the 15th year, KDFW and the City of Dallas joined together to support reading and STEM initiatives over the summer. FOX 4 anchor Clarice Tinsley and Mayor Eric Johnson teamed up (separately) to tout the program.



MARCH FOR BABIES

The annual march was virtual in May, but Fox 4’s Heather Hays and Brandon still acted as emcees for the May fundraiser, and participated in the PSA.



BIG CLIMB DALLAS

Relocated from January to May, this annual event for the Leukemia and Lymphoma society became a “climb where you are” event, with plans to return to an in-person event early 2022.




OPAL’S WALK TO DC (JUNETEENTH)
