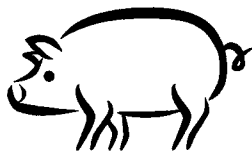

Please bring your driver's license. Our staff may be able to copy or scan your driver's license to get your name, age, and address. This speeds up the data entry process which means less time at the clinic for you and shorter lines!

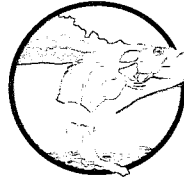

Caliber, Conservation, Hypothermia, are you familiar with these words? If not, you need to attend the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission **Hunter Education Course** to be held at the Fred Berry Conservation Education Center on Crooked Creek.

This **free** class will be held Saturday, December 12th from 8am to 6pm.

This **free** course is required for anyone born on or after January 1st, 1969 who wishes to hunt.

The course includes such topics as firearms safety, conservation, wildlife management, sportsmanship, archery, muzzleloading, first aid and survival, and other hunting information.

The purpose of the regulation and the course is to inform and educate those enjoying the great outdoors which will lead to safer and more responsible behavior by all outdoorsmen throughout the state. The course is free of charge and is open to anyone although the presented material is at the 6th grade level.

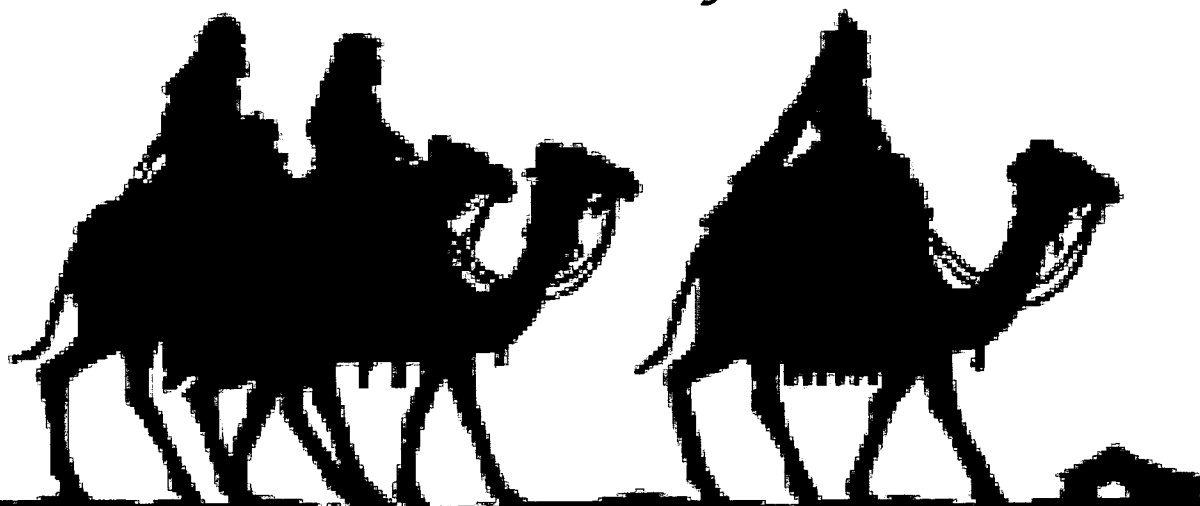

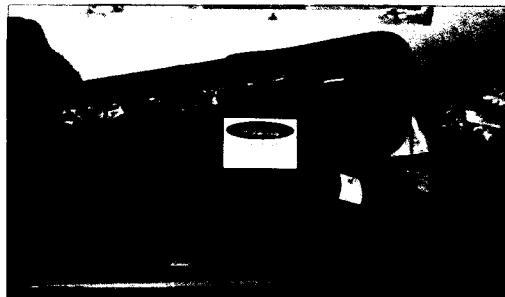
