**BRIEF OUTLINE OF NEWS STORY: Body Recovered
from Lake Winnebago Boating Accident in Bad Weather**

EXHIBIT, IF AVAILABLE:

The body of one of the two canoers presumed drowned in Lake Winnebago has been recovered, according to Fond du Lac County sheriff's officials.

Sonar devices used by the sheriff and Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources search teams produced an image late Wednesday afternoon that sent divers into the water to investigate. They recovered an adult male matching the description of one of the victims. The search for the second victim was suspended because the sun had set, the winds were strong and temperatures were below freezing, according to the sheriff's office.

The search for the second man resumes Thursday.

Dakota Goldapske and Michael Gohde, both 21, ventured out on the lake Monday night after dark and in choppy conditions. Officials say they were about a mile north of the Fond du Lac River outlet when dispatchers took a 911 call from one of them.

Sheriff's officials said at the time of the call, both were still in the canoe, but were thrown into the water a short time later. Neither had a life jacket.

Multiple agencies have been searching for the victims since then while friends and family members wait on shore.

BRIEF OUTLINE OF NEWS STORY: Several Suspects
ID'd in Rash of Vandalism in City of New Holstein

EXHIBIT, IF AVAILABLE:

Several law enforcement agencies have helped identify several suspects involved in vandalism, theft and possession of drugs in the City of New Holstein.

According to the Calumet County Sheriff's, the investigation started April 6 when New Holstein police officers noticed vandalism that happened to a building in Civic Park. A theft had also occurred from a local business and a water fountain was ripped off the wall at the concession stand at New Holstein High School.

Officials located multiple suspects over two days, a 17-year-old, a 14-year-old and a 16-year-old, all from the Fox Valley area are facing charges of Obstructing an Officer and Damage to Property.

While looking for the suspects, officials also arrested a 17-year-old Kiel resident and an 18-year-old New Holstein resident for possessing various forms of THC and Drug Paraphernalia.

BRIEF OUTLINE OF NEWS STORY: Food Assistance
Restored for 400,000 Households in the State.

Hundreds of thousands of Wisconsin households have had their food assistance restored. Late Tuesday afternoon, Wisconsin Governor Tony Evers announced his administration has reached a deal with the United States Department of Agriculture, as well as the Food (USDA) and Nutrition Service (FNS).

The Wisconsin Supreme Court struck down Evers' public health emergency and mask mandate on March 31.

The court's order left the state under no emergency or disaster declaration, which is required to receive food assistance benefits from the federal government during the pandemic.

After working with Evers, the USDA has agreed to a deal preserving more than \$70 million a month in benefits for more than 400,000 households in the state.
