IN KIEL. ONE PERSON TREATED
FOR SMOKE INHALATION.

WLAK -One person was treated for possible smoke inhalation and taken to a local hospital after a house fire in Kiel on Tuesday.

Around 2:06 p.m. the Kiel Fire Department responded to a house on Linden Street for a report of the back of a house on fire with three people and pets possibly still inside.

While responding, the department requested additional fire departments to the scene.

Upon arrival, heavy smoke and flames were visible from the rear of the house.

One person in the home was able to evacuate prior to the arrival of firefighters and confirmed they were the only one inside. Fire crews immediately began fire suppression and search efforts. During a primary search of the home, two pets were rescued by Kiel Fire personnel. The fire was knocked down in about ten minutes.

WLAK A sewer project in Chilton is leaving a major roadway closed for the rest of November.

According to the Calumet County Twitter page, starting on Monday, crews in Chilton will begin improving their water main and sanitary sewer system on County Road G from the intersection with Highway 32/57, to about 900 feet south.

Highway G will be closed through the rest of November between the highway intersections and MB Lane.

Traffic is being detoured using MB Lane, Highway 32/57, and Madison Street.

ANNOUNCES 6% OF NEWS STAFF TO
BE LAID OFF

Gannett Media has announced it will lay off 6% of its staff in the News Division effective December 1st. It's estimated 200 people will lose their jobs in this most recent cost-cutting measure. About 400 employees were laid off earlier this year.

Gannett Media owns newspapers in 45 states, 11 of these publications are in Wisconsin, including The Sheboygan Press, **the Herald Times Reporter**, the Green Press Gazette, and the Post Crescent in Appleton.

The Company has implemented additional cost-cutting measures including, pausing its 401(k) match, offering employees a voluntary severance plan, and is having workers take five days of unpaid leave.

Gannett Media has forecast a total net loss of \$60 million to \$70 million for the year as
