Authorities say two men who they were searching for earlier in the day due to a shooting in Calumet County have now turned themselves in.

According to the Calumet County Sheriff's Office, the two men, who are Hispanic and in their mid-30's, have ties to the Fox Valley area.

The investigation into the shooting, which happened at Blu Sapphires Cabaret just after 2:30 a.m. on Sunday, and injured a 40-year-old Kaukauna man.

The man, who was shot in the abdomen, is expected to recover.

INCREASES FORCING CIRCUIT COURTS TO
SUSPEND IN-PERSON PROCEEDINGS.

Brown and Outagamie county circuit courts have been ordered to suspend in-person court proceedings for the next two weeks, through October 13.

Courts will be allowed to continue proceedings remotely.

The order came from Eighth Judicial District Chief James Morrison, who said he made the decision with advice by Prevea president/CEO and consultation with the affected judges and the Director of State Courts.

Morrison said the order is meant to reduce the need for public gatherings of 10 or more people and the order may be extended.
