The organization attempting to recall Wisconsin Gov. Tony Evers announced on Monday that it would be suspending its efforts after not meeting the number of signatures needed to trigger a recall election.

"As we come to the conclusion of this effort, and we realize our numbers are short, we want our volunteers to hold their heads high and be proud of what was accomplished," said the Recall Evers Committee in a release.

The Racine Journal Times said the petition's organizer, Misty Polewczynski, filed the paperwork with the Wisconsin Elections Commission in August, stating that Evers and Lt. Gov. Mandela Barnes were "unfit for office."

Polewczynski recently faced allegations that she was misleading media outlets about the number of signatures the organization had received for the effort after social media posts showed conflicting information. Polewczynski had told the Journal Times that she had surpassed over 600,000 signatures and then told the State Journal that she had surpassed the threshold.

Wisconsin's elections chief says there remains no evidence of any wrongdoing, fraud or irregularity in the state's presidential election, as counties work to wrap up certifying their votes and estimating how much it would cost to recount them.

Elections chief Meagan Wolfe said Thursday that nothing unusual has come up during the county certification of the votes.

Fifty- five of the state's 72 counties have completed the certification and Democrat Joe Biden has netted just four votes.

Based on unofficial counts, Biden beat President Donald Trump by about 20,500 votes.

Tuesday is the deadline for counties to complete the vote canvass.

WLAK The body of a hunter missing since October 29 was recovered Monday from the Manitowoc River.

The Manitowoc County Sheriff's office confirms it's the body of Joshua Lueptow, who was the subject of a number of search efforts over the past months.

Lueptow was duck hunting on the river. The sheriff's office received a report of a hunter in distress on Oct. 29 but couldn't find Lueptow.

Monday afternoon, a private search and rescue organization using sonar and a submarine drone found Lueptow in 5 to 6 feet of water. The Manitowoc County sheriff's dive team responded and recovered the body shortly before 2:30.

*Kyle Rittenhouse held over for trial in  
Kenosha Shootings.*

There is enough evidence to warrant a trial for an Illinois 17-year-old accused of killing two men and wounding a third during a night of unrest in Wisconsin, a court commissioner ruled Thursday after a contentious hearing in which the defendant's lawyer tried to show he had acted in self-defense.

Kyle Rittenhouse, of Antioch, Illinois, is charged with homicide and attempted homicide for the Aug. 25 fatal shootings of Joseph Rosenbaum and Anthony Huber and the wounding of Gaige Grosskreutz during a night of unrest two days after the police shooting in Kenosha of Jacob Blake, a local Black man.

During a preliminary hearing conducted via video, Kenosha County Circuit Court Commissioner Loren Keating found that there was enough probable cause for the case to proceed to trial. Rittenhouse told police he was attacked while guarding someone's business and that he fired in self-defense. He was freed from jail last month after posting \$2 million bond, with most of the money raised through a legal defense fund set up by conservatives who view him as a patriot who was protecting other people's property.

According to the Fond du Lac County Sheriff's Office, a search took place throughout the week to identify the driver of a white or silver pickup truck that had crashed into a telephone pole in the Pipe area and had fled the scene.

Deputies say while fleeing the scene, the driver had left a buck and a doe behind which authorities believe had been harvested during that same weekend in the Fond du Lac or Calumet County area.

After posting a picture of the harvested buck on the Fond du Lac County Sheriff's Office Facebook page asking the community's help in locating the driver, deputies shared an update on Friday that with the help of the residents, the investigation had come to an end and the driver of the incident had been found.

Officials report the driver received multiple traffic citations.
