WVAZ provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **Aretha Franklin's Legacy, Better Man than Me:** This morning we (tm)re going to depart from our normal discussion of the topical news of the past week and devote the majority of this morning (tm)s show to the Queen of Soul. This morning we (tm)ll remember Ken with Sun-times reporter and friend Maudlyne E-here-rik-jaricka and Jack Lynch director of Community Affairs with the Gift of Hope Organ and Tissue Donor Network. We (tm)ll also get this 411 on this year (tm)s annual congressional black caucus week in Washington DC and learn about the Chicago Urban Leagues town hall meeting tomorrow which I will moderate from Congressman Danny Davis. And will close out this morning (tm)s discussions on high note as learn about this year (tm)s Sista Strut walk to end breast cancer and the Sister (tm)s network of Chicago.
- **Dan Ryan Protest March, Soul Yoga Festival :** This morning we (tm)re going to devote much of the morning to this pivotal event in Chicago (tm)s struggle to address its number one problem Crime. We (tm)ll be joined by March organizer Father Michael Pflieger and Rev. Jesse Jackson as well as a number of people who participated in the protests. - **L McDonald Case, Gun Violence, Dress for Success** : Actor, writer director producer Mario Van Peebles has a new movie out the takes head on the volatile issues of gun violence and mental health. It (tm)s called Armed and it (tm)s a jarring cinematic experience. This morning we (tm)ll talk live to the multi-talented movie maker about his film and his take on violence in the city of Chicago. It (tm)s said that in order to get the part you have to look the part. For nearly two decades Dress for Success has provided women here in Chicago and across the country the wardrobe and skills sets training they need to land gainful employment. President Trump attacks the media and Lebron James, a state representative steps down after reportedly catfishing nude photos of his former girl friend and new legal trouble for Dorothy Brown and Willie Wilson is accused of trying to buy votes. And we (tm)ll end our conversations talking about the numerous film offerings available at this year (tm)s Black Harvest Film Festival.
- **McDonald Murder Case, Bill Cosby Sentencing, DLS** : This morning we (tm)ll review the defense (tm)s case with the journalist who broke the LaQuan McDonald story Jamie Kalven of the invisible institute and former Chicago Cop Richard Wooten of the Gathering Point Community Council. Wooten has drafted a plan to encourage community leaders to be proactive to avoid violence in the community in the event of an acquittal or hung jury verdict in the case. The 82-year Cosby is now labeled a "sexually violent predator," and is currently in a 7 by 13 feet prison cell serving a 3 to 10 sentence. What does this mean for African Americans as we head into the mid term elections? We (tm)ll pose those questions to you as well as social advocates Kristal High Taylor of nFluence. And we (tm)ll close out this morning show hearing about the dirty little secrets for Men only conference with Founder Louis Carr.
- **McDonald Trial, Mayoral Elections, Gift of Hope** : Back here the trial of Jason Van Dyke the Chicago Cop accused of murdering LaQuan McDonald began with Jury Selection. We (tm)ll get an update on the closely watched trial and what it will mean for the city of Chicago. This morning we (tm)ll hear from one of the deans of Chicago Politics UIC professor Dick Simpson as we preview the chances of the growing field of candidates. And most importantly we (tm)ll take your calls on Rahm (tm)s stunning decision. And we (tm)ll end this morning (tm)s discussions on a high note as we talk to Marion Shuck of Community

Partner Gift of Hope Organ and Tissue Donor network.

- **Protests Effectiveness, Mayor's Race:** Rev. Gregory Seal Livingston of the Coalition for a new Chicago. Livingston has appeared on this program before to talk about his shutdown of lake shore drive and subsequent march to Wrigley Field. Now he plans on shutting down the Kennedy expressway as part of his shutdown of Ohare campaign. Why is he protesting this way and is it effective are just a few of the questions that we (tm)ll ask him. First there was 11, now there could be as many as a baker's dozen, or 13 people running to become the next mayor of Chicago. This week former mayoral candidate, community activist Amara Enyia declared that she is once again going to seek the office. And add yet another name to the mix as Jerry Joyce Jr., the son of former 19th Ward alderman and state Sen. Jeremiah Joyce, filed paperwork to run for the office.
