NARRATIVE: In the representatives' presence of the community congress man Bob Filner visited today the Imperial Valley to raise solutions to diverse problems that they bother to the county.

Filner said: we hope to open a clinic with finished service for veterans in 1 or 2 months it will be good for the Valley. Also one touch the topic of the medical service for undocumented persons. If someone is receiving medical attention and if it is undocumented the Federal Government should take charge for that at present the hospitals are paying this service.

Vivian Perez, Assistant of the Forum said: it is well that there are funds for the illegal ones but also my worry is that it is going to do for these members of the community who have no insurance those who are here legally and those who are citizens of the United States that it is going to do to help them with the medical care.

But the long lines there was one of the principal topics. Conferee Filner showed that the people in Washington think that having long lines it is to be sure.

Filner, today we have the resources they can open all the doors 24 hours and that would eliminate the long lines without need of any more technology only with more agents throughout the day.

Perez; they need to take hold more officials put more money on the border that not only complain but that do something for the community without putting the money in on the border and that more officials occupy.

To finish the Mr. Filner reaffirmed his slogan to this topic efficiency is a safety and that should to destine the money used for frontier matters to fight those who put in risk to our nation and not those who only come to do to him a good to the country on having come from buys or to work.

DATE: 01-07-08 **TITLE:** Arrest Canal Todo Americano.

NARRATIVE: During this weekend the frontier patrol sector El Centro seized more than 100 pounds sterling of marijuana the particular of this case is that they were received just in the moment in which 4 individuals deposited in an illegal way this country for the Canal Todo Americano, 2 of them are already after the grills.

Enrique Lozano, Frontier Patrol Sector El Centro, said:

These two persons were arrested, down the arrest could state that the individuals had 10 bundles that were containing 110 pounds sterling of marijuana and that were deposited to the country illegally.

The incident registered 10 miles to the East of the cabin new Mexicali where, after crossing the Canal Todo Americano in a raft, 2 of the individuals tried trasportar the drug in bicycle whereas others 2 managed to return to Mexico.

Lozano; good others 2 persons were returned to Mexico that they have being one of the tactics that the smugglers use to join this case drugs or in his shortcoming also they can be persons who try to enter illegally to this country.

Although other more usual ways exist to try to cross drugs illegally to this country what one saw this weekend is of attracting attention.

It is not so common more nevertheless it is something for that it is possible to wait inside the methods for that the smugglers are looking to be able to spend his illicit goods to this country.

In what it goes of this year they take taken into account 3323 pounds sterling of marijuana seized with a value for 2,6 million dollars.

NARRATIVE: The increasing insecurity that is lived in the tourist broker Tijuana – Rosarito – Ensenada, worries the authorities of Mexicali where there is had the fear of losing the inflow of foreign visitors especially of the United States.

Victor Manuel Rodriguez, President of COTUCO Mexicali;

If we worry from what it is going on there because this bad publicity now if it is going to affect us indirectly here if it is that we do not take the necessary measures. Some of these measurements it is to have police corporations that offer protection and I support the visitors, but the lenders of services of this capital more than to worry for what Coast is happening in the zone must put oneself on attention to what happens on this border.

Jose Luis Garcia, used of pharmacy;

It scares them for the thefts in the cars they steal cover you with matting many things, they assault the people, that's why I believe that if governess affected here to the commerce of here.

Ruben Saucedo, cabdriver;

For that nobody wants to come to El Centro and is where there is very much I am in danger here. To what the President of COTUCO Mexicali answered.

Rodriguez; it is important well that we have forceful security measure and this is what it is doing and what is already happening with the Federal support of 3 levels of government.

Mister Rodriguez added that up to the moment there is seen a decrease of 4 % in the hotel occupation in this entity but stems from the growth of this sector whereas in the rest of the state the panorama is very different. Rodriguez; we calculate that if it walks between 10, 12, 13 % that has lowered and grown them the hotel offer, whereas the local business also has been seen afectdos by this situation.

Garcia; since put 50 % that if the same insecurity has affected that.

Saucedo; here one day they struck a Gentleman dragged it beat him with the destre of the phone nobody ran it stopped it nobody wants to get into problems I saw when a burglar to a gentleman who was there average slept with a razor broke the bag and took the portfolio. NARRATIVE: Today the mayor of Calexico Mr. John Renison realizes of what is doing to itself in this city during this one his management. For this Louis Fuentes member of the council mentions that in safety aspect they are fine since the new chief of police officer has just be named in addition to the hiring of more officials but undoubtedly one of the principal topics that they bother to this entity they are the long lines to cross the cabins. Fuentes, he said: to chatting in Washington with the representatives of us and other affiliates equally with the border to improve that thing about the crossing for which it affects us enough in the commerce of the city. Sandra Prado, merchant said: they must improve the lines so much on foot as in car because it is so much the over crowded that the people prefer not coming. Fuentes, already in fact the congress is authorizing a study to be able discover which is the real cost that causes us when the frontier crossing is become so length of 2, 3 hours. Whereas the average is already prepared by the merchants. Meadow; if enough 80 %. Although there is another factor that worries the lenders of services and they believe that also it affects that to his establishments. The parking because it comes and puts him to the meter and thinks that it can be 4, 5 hours when not at all more sound 2 hours and that fine them and that do not find parking easily either. Fuentes; one is chatting with some proprietors of areas where the building is not used to 100 % to see the possibility of having structures of several flats for parking for employees equally for the people to be parked there. In accordance with residents to have an economic growth there must be major sources of work. Resident; nothing else, more employments so that the people who has no work work, more employments because there are unemployed many. Fuentes; this is a little a very strong approach of me in the personal thing and of the council we are moving so that there is a structure of economic development stronger than we have had. NARRATIVE: Yesterday about 11 a.m. the department of the sheriff of Yuma received a call bringing an individual shooting a firearm in Wellton Arizona city that one finds to 30 miles to the East of Yuma. The suspect was already brave.

Eben Bratcher, Dept. Sheriff of Yuma; the person in the jeep the first time was shouting and the second time was shooting a gun at the local community for another direction. For some workpeople of this area the incidental unnoticed step because at this hour of the day it is common to listen to detonations to frighten the birds of the farmings.

Anonymous; at this hour if there are many shots that's why it was we who do not notice every morning there are many birds but at about 12 a.m. of the day for forward it is already calmed. But thanks to whom if they managed to identify to the subject who was travelling round the avenue of the county number 7 one found the vehicle which had suffered an accident. Bratcher; with the information that the witnesses gave us we could look and the documents in the jeep we could meet on the suspect, it was arrested by the charges of assault by aggravating circumstances.

Fortunately it had not injured and the mobile of the crime continues under investigation. We do not know if it was shooting anybody in particular we have not found a motive of the crime to this point, there is possibility that has been under the influence of the alcohol.

Jose Mora, Engineer Group Entravision El Centro; the difference of transmit a similar digital channel and a channel that if the this person in a distant place but his system stops a minimal level of reception, the quality of reception will be the same that if it was on the foot of the antenna that wants to say this is that the sign will be 100 %.

Although for some this change is still confused.

Rafael Alfaro, Resident; I do not like because we are going to have to buy any device or are going to have to pay any monthly quota and already having our own antenna.

Conferee; if there are persons who have a similar traditional television that they have the antenna on the television or an antenna in the roof it is necessary to buy a converter a box or service of cable or buy a digital television.

Alfaro; or that the one that does not have this device is not going to look at television now?

Conferee; and in case they want the box converter that request us a coupon and we are going to send to them a coupon for 40 dollars in the buy of a box converter.

NARRATIVE: In accordance with the safety department of the United States there has happened a whole of 226 incursions of police Mexican agents to American territory along the border, 60 of which in the stripe Calexico Mexicali.

Pablo Arnuaud Carreño, Consul of Mexico in Calexico; in the emulation of the pursuit of the crime in many occasions the border is not signposted properly or the sand of the desert where mainly they happen these cases cover the mojoneras.

The statistics showed in the study of the Federal Agency it includes last 10 years. For the frontier patrol sector El Centro the incursions of Mexican agents are made unusual.

Enrique Lozano, Frontier Patrol Sector El Centro; every case is particular and in every case we are going to see the details and to fight with what it happened in this moment of the incursion.

Arnaud; we order them an office denouncing the fact or vice versa we also.

Up to the moment incidents have not registered between police corporations.

The same authorities give notice and in 100 % of the cases they ask them to return to his territory, there has been up to now no arrest this way. What if it exists is a work of set for combator the crime on the border.

Lozano, is a program in two countries, we are as a whole and spending information to arrest or aprehender to these persons who in a given moment go away to Mexico or vice versa in a moment since some person goes so far as to come to the United States.

DATE: 01-15-08 TITLE: Training to Marines

LENGTH: 1:55

PROGRAM: Notivalle

NARRATIVE: A whole of 28 soldiers of the marina of the United States came to the Imperial Valley to receive training that they were using in his next mission in the Middle East.

William Simmons, Marine; as following individuals in the desert, as looking for signs, to look between the shrubs, to look for cruises and things like that.

For the military men it is very important to get this type of training for the people who is employed at similar areas that surely they will see in his next trip. To train here with the frontier patrol that are of the best in the country since they have a lot of experience doing it and have qualified well individuals and to come to learn here of an ambience to which probably we are going to be sent makes us be prepared well.

Enrique Lozano, frontier Patrol; this ambience in the area in which we are in the Imperial Valley is similar to what they are going to be in ambiances to where they are going to be sent. This is the first time that comes personnel of the armed forces to realize this type of activities with the frontier patrol in what it goes of this fiscal year, according to the same soldiers they say that to learn in this desert is very subtle since there are no other places where they could receive the same training.

Simmons; now we can use what we learned with the frontier patrol as following individuals for example or seeing the incursions or footpaths in the desert that we could not know but had the training that we had here. But the training not only belongs concerning persecution to individuals on foot but also to false papers.

We have that of the reserves where they also are taking experience and are fixed as we are covering the operations, also we have as to identify the false documents for them they apply these skills dodne they they are going to use them.

This group of soldiers of the marina of the United States will divide course to Iraq and Afghanistan in date without confirming.

DATE: 01-17-08 TITLE: Approval Yuma Arena.

LENGTH: 20 sec.V.O.

PROGRAM: Notivalle

NARRATIVE: Approval Yuma Arena. The chapter of Yuma decided for 4 votes 3 to continue with the planeacion of the center multiuses for this city. The construction of the above mentioned sand will be financed by bonds of the city as well as of taxes received from commerce and restaurants. 4 million dollars hope to be collected to continue with the project that of be completing will open his doors between 2009 and 2010. The building will cost a whole for 53 million dollars, will lodge different sports events and spectacles, with a capacity for 6 thousand spectators.

NARRATIVE: The area of Yuma Arizona grew 50 % from 1990 to 2000 and actualmnte one of three places is considered with major growth of the country, due to these factors including that consumes more energy in the hearths, the corporate commission of Arizona approved the installation of a line of high place voltage from the nuclear power station of Palo Verde that will have a length of 110 miles, it will cost next to 250 million dollars and the work hopes to be finished for 2012.

NARRATIVE: Last Saturday an agent of the frontier patrol sector Yuma lost the life in the fulfillment of his duty. 32-year-old Luis Aguilar of age was trying to stop one of 2 vehicles that deposited in an illegal way the United States.

Michael Bernacke, Patrol Fornteriza Sector Yuma; the smugglers managed on the South for the Imperial Sand Dunes.

Steven Norman, Witness; I him become attached to the agent of the frontier patrol enter the way and try to go for the ramp of exit and it went away to the desert like to 70 or 80 miles per hour. The agent Aguilar was placing a device to deflate the rims of the suspicious vehicle when it was hasty.

Bernacke; a hummer coffee managed towards the agent Aguilar and knocked down it with the car, the hummer continued towards the South Mexico and also Ford F-150 went away to Mexico. In an unofficial way it is known that the vehicle was found in the common land Coronitas in the Valley of Mexicali, as well as this witness comments on it. Norman; they found the vehicle hours later in Mexicali a H2 Hummer the were set fire.

The investigation is in charge of the FBI and one is employed at coordination with Mexican authorities to meet on the persons in charge of this lamentable case.

Bernacke; if we have spoken with the police of Mexico also the military service and they are helping us to seize the smugglers. Original Luis Aguilar of El Paso Texas his wife and 2 sons survive, it is not even known when it will be the funeral service. □

DATE: 01-21-08 **TITLE:** Mexicalenses students.

PROGRAM: Notivalle

NARRATIVE: 300 pupils mexicalenses have been expelled from public schools of Calexico in the last 2 years for not verifying his residence in this city.

The superintendent of the school district David Alvarez showed that it is not a "cazeria" against undocumented students, added that the people do not understand that the community of very annoying this Calexico, which they pay of his pockets, and which sometimes in spite of living facing a school the children do not reach place and others that do not live there if. I add that it will be continued by this measurement and if the family parents want that his children study in this school district they must pay or inscribe them in particular schools.

DATE: 01-22-08 TITLE: Border Patrol Follow Up.

NARRATIVE: 2 days after the death of the agent of the frontier patrol Luis Aguilar, the state preventive police of Baja California located a vehicle hummer set fire intentionally in the common land Coronitas in the Valley of Mexicali. It is analyzed to the above mentioned unit to verify if it is the same with which I take him the life from the official. Meanwhile already there is prepared the funeral of Luis Aguilar who will be this Thursday at 10 a.m. time of California in the Civic Center of Yuma. To the agent Luis Aguilar survive his wife and 2 sons.

DATE: 01-22-08 TITLE: Fatal accident in the interstate.

LENGTH: 25 sec.V.O.

PROGRAM: Notivalle

NARRATIVE: About 2 p.m. 8 registered a fatal accident in the interstate highway in El Centro. A woman who was travelling in a black pick up entered the highway the opposite sense impactandose straight ahead with one ford expedition hangs which with the blow flew and fell down on a pick up. The driver of the black pick up died in the scene of the accident whereas the crew members of others 2 vehicles were transported to the hospital of El Centro with multiple injuries.

The state of health of both is brought like very seriously. The highway will remain closed from the street fourth to the Imperial avenue until the vehicles are withdrawn. Up to the moment the names of the involved ones were not announced. The investigations even continue to clarify this tragic accident.

DATE: 01-23-08 **TITLE:** Officials of Calexico in Washington.

PROGRAM: Notivalle

NARRATIVE: Officials of the city of Calexico are of tour in Washington to meet diverse federal representatives. In the first conversations is tackled the topic of the long lines to cross the cabins of this city. There exhibited the possible expansion of cabin East and the creation of a new port of entry in a nearby future. Also they announced the negative impact in the economy that leave the long times of the frontier cruze. The local covey will remain in the capital of the country 2 more days where other needs of this community will talk each other.

DATE: 01-24-08 **TITLE:** Border Patrol Funeral.

PROGRAM: Notivalle

NARRATIVE: Today was one of 2 funeral services that there will have the agent of the frontier patrol Luis Aguilar who lost the life tragically last January 19 in the Dunes of the County of Imperial, when he tried to place a device to deflate the rims of a vehicle that had entered illegally the United States this zone. A fact that left big sadness and indignation between the agents of this corporation and his family.

Marco Antonio Aguilar, Brother of the Deceased Agent; I am angered for what I happen but also I am very proud of my brother of his work he was a good worker.

Marco Antonio Aguilar brother of the fallen down agent affected enough by this lamentable loss only he asks that clear the case.

Aguilar; I loved very much my brother, my brother was strong, dear, he loved his wife to his children to his parents to his brothers and also to the border patrol And does the family want justice??? If we want justice. Justice which there faces already Jesus Albino Navarro 22-year-old of age, which arrest registered in people Yaqui, community on the South of Ciudad Obregon, Sonora. And it is accused of the murder of the agent Aguilar, in an area of recreation in the County of Imperial.

Bridge: Retana, we are in the Dunes of the County of Imperial approximately 40 miles to the East of the city of El Centro, California; it was precisely this place where the agent of the frontier patrol Luis Aguilar lost the life, some of the visitors of this area have left flowers in his memory. Meanwhile it has not decided where Jesus Navarro Montes will be already sued in accordance with the article quarter of the penal federal code, the crimes committed in foreign territory by a Mexican against Mexicans or foreigners they will be punished in Mexico.

Although the possible extradition of Navarro Montes is not discarded since the government of United States needs it for the murder of the federal agent.

Aguilar; I cannot mention in that, only that, the I just want justice to be serve, the second funeral service will be in his hometown The Paso Texas, next Monday, the 28th. From Yuma Arizona Abraham Retana Univision.

DATE: 01-25-08 TITLE: US Passport Card.

LENGTH: 1:50

PROGRAM: Notivalle

NARRATIVE: From January 31 the citizens of United States will have to have more than his verbal declaration of US citizen to cross the cabins. Beginning this date they will have to show an official identification together with his passport, but if you have not acquired one it can do what Angelica de Cima spokeswoman of the customs department and frontier protection recommends.

De Cima; from the first of February they are going to be able to request a card of passport card, and it is going to be available in April those who have this card are going to be able to use her to cross the terrestrial cabins and for sea.

Mendoza; I like for that this way one is not battling so much and I believe that it is more rapid and the emigrant does not last so much in being investigate and all that.

This new card will cost 45 dollars for adults, 35 for children and if you already have passport and wish this card will cost him 20 dollars.

De Cima; if it has no passport they can obtain it and use as passport but it cannot use it for plane, they cannot use it if they are going to enter a flight of another country for of course a passport deals. For some this might bring benefits at the time of crossing the cabins.

Mendoza; so since the photo of the person comes and there comes all the information for that they are looking.

Lopez; it is more rapid and you do not have to do so many line because earlier not at all any more tapeworms that to teach the record but this is more rapid anything more spend it round there they ask you about your name, where you live and it is already quite. In addition to this new card US passport also it can use the card sentri to be identified in case of having with it his passport.

DATE: 01-28-08 TITLE: Interstate 8 death.

NARRATIVE: Another person died as result of the accident of last week in the interstate highway 8. Jenny Cortez 26-year-old of El Centro California died in a hospital of San Diego due to the multiple internal wounds received in the accident. When his vehicle was impacted for other that entered sense opposite to this route. The driver of the black pick up who entered erroneously to the way died in the scene, whereas Joseph Dhaliwal from Holtville third involved in the accident it recovers of wounds in the hand and right shoulder.

DATE: 01-28-08 **TITLE:** Passport Follow Up.

PROGRAM: Notivalle

NARRATIVE: For all those that have the citizenship of the United States listen well. From January 31 if you think to travel to Mexico he will need more than his verbal declaration of US Citizen to cross on returning to this country. It will occupy already be his passport, card SENTRI or the new card US Passport, which will be able to acquire it to partor of the First of February, it will have a cost for 45 dollars for adults, 35 for children and 20 dollars if you are already provided with a passport. The customs department of the United States mentioned that, if, on having crossed the border, it is needed to rise questions to the person, they will do it in the secondary examination to improve the traffic in cabins.

DATE: 01-28-08 **TITLE:** Calexico in Washington.

PROGRAM: Notivalle

NARRATIVE: In one Officials' visit of Calexico suffers to the capital of the country there exhibited some of the problematic ones to which this frontier city faces especially the long lines to cross the cabins and since it affects this to the local economy and to the commercial development of the zone. John Renison, we have to have this continuity this flow of 7, 9 squares to cover the hollows that exist here in the customs, and then the expansion of the new cabin at 24 these hours they are our immediate goals and in the long term it is the opening of a new cabin for 2012.

DATE: 01-29-08 **TITLE:** Border Patrol Follow Up.

PROGRAM: Notivalle

NARRATIVE: Jesus Navarro Montes 22-year-old, principal suspicious of the murder to the agent of the frontier patrol Luis Aguilar might face the charges that impute him to him before the Mexican laws. That in case of being a convict might happen up to 50 years of jail. In case of his extradition to the Navarro Montes United States it might face the possible capital punishment. Jesus Navarro was arrested in Sonora 3 days after the agent Luis Aguilar was losing the life when it was wound while he was placing a device to deflate the rims of a vehicle hummer that entered illegally the country and that later fled to Mexico.

DATE: 01-29-08 TITLE: Imperial Valley Accidents.

PROGRAM: Notivalle

NARRATIVE: Yesterday was register other accident in the Imperial Valley. 3 persons died when the pick up in which they were travelling was impacted for a tract truck in the intersection of Shank and the highway 115 to the North of Brawley. With this one 4 accidents go in this month with 7 fatal victims.
