Dr Reeves came to urge listeners to be careful when out in the sun. He insisted we use a sunscreen even in the shade. He explained the different rays of the sun which are ultra violet, which are UV ,UVC and UVBs. Each of these rays has a different reaction toward the skin. The UVC tends to seek out the eperdermus and the melenan cells that then will morf into renegade cells that later can turn to cancer. We often hear about basil cell carcinoma or the bad one malignant melanoma. He relates that applying sunscreen numerous times a day if you are going to be out for an extended period of time will give you the protection you need for outdoor activities. He then talked about healthy living and the opening statement was Don't Smoke! Eat a good healthy diet of veggies and lean meats with no more than one drink for women and 2 for men of alcoholic beverages. Keep a normal weight, and make exercise a habit.
