"THEY HAVE OFFERED TO FUND IT TO DO LABOR TO DO WORK TO BRING A BENCH, WHATEVER WE NEED, THEY HAVE OFFERED TO COME AND SUPPORT THEM. THAT WAY IT WILL BE BIGGER AND BETTER FOR SURE." "IT MADE ME EVEN MORE APPRECIATIVE OF OUR COMMUNITY ABOUT WHAT THIS MEMORIAL STANDS FOR. IT'S NOT JUST ABOUT THE TWO GIRLS - IT'S ABOUT THE COMMUNITY."

"THEY HAVE MAINTENANCE PEOPLE THAT DON'T GIVE A CRAP ABOUT THE PEOPLE OVER HERE." WAIT, THERE'S MORE. SHE SAYS UNITS ACROSS THE COMPLEX, LIKE HERS, ARE WITHOUT AIR CONDITIONING. "WE'RE SWEATING. POLICE SAY WHEN OFFICER XENG LOR APPROACHED HIM HE TRIED TO HIT HIM. THAT'S WHEN LOR FIRED HIS GUN. AFTER SPEEDING OFF CALLISTE LATER SHOWED UP TO THE HOSPITAL WITH 2 GUN SHOT WOUNDS. DESPITE NUMEROUS WARRANTS IN SOUTH CAROLINA, CALLISTE'S GRANDMOTHER SAYS IT'S NOT LIKE HIM. "XAVIER WOULD NOT RAISE A HAND TO AN OFFICIAL. HE WAS IN THE MILITARY UNTIL HE WAS KICKED OUT. A ROCK HILL WOMAN IS ACCUSED OF RIPPING OFF PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES AND GOING ON HER OWN PERSONAL SHOPPING SPREES. OUR ROBIN KANADY EXPLAINS HOW SHE WAS ABLE TO DO IT, WITH THEIR FOOD STAMP ACCOUNTS. "FOR SOMEONE TO DO THAT, THAT JUST GOES AGAINST MORALITY." 22-YEAR OLD KYLIE DAVIS WORKED WITH ADULTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS, AND SHE HELPED HERSELF TO THEIR MONEY, ACCORDING TO POLICE. STAFF AT THE YORK COUNTY BOARD OF DISABILITIES AND SPECIAL NEEDS NOTICED SOMETHING WAS UP WHEN THEY MADE THEIR ROUTINE CHECKS OF RESIDENTS' FOOD STAMP ACCOUNTS. "ONCE WE NOTED THE AREA OF CONCERN, WE ADDRESSED IT IMMEDIATELY." POLICE GOT INVOLVED. THEY SAY DAVIS, WHOSE JOB IT WAS TO GO GROCERY SHOPPING WITH THE RESIDENTS AT BROWN VILLAS ON LONGVIEW ROAD, TOOK THEIR FOOD STAMP ACCOUNTS AND BOUGHT

THINGS AT THIS WAL-MART NEIGHBORHOOD MARKET ON CHERRY ROAD FOR HERSELF. OVER A FEW MONTHS, AUTHORITIES SAY DAVIS STOLE MORE THAN \$350 WORTH OF ITEMS. "ALWAYS IT'S AN INITIAL SHOCK, SURPRISE, DISAPPOINTMENT, ANGRY." DAVIS QUIT HER JOB AS SOON AS SHE KNEW SHE WAS BEING INVESTIGATED, LEADERS SAY. AND SHE GAVE HERSELF UP TO POLICE, CHARGED WITH EXPLOITING VULNERABLE ADULTS. BUT IT'S HER FORMER CO-WORKERS WHO NOW HAVE TO EXPLAIN TO THE RESIDENTS THAT NOT EVERYONE IS OUT TO GET THEM. "I'M SURE THERE'S TRUST ISSUES AND SO WE HAVE TO MAKE SURE THEY ARE AWARE THAT WE ARE LOOKING OUT FOR THEM. WE ALWAYS WANT TO MAKE SURE THAT THEY ARE PROTECTED AND KNOW THAT WE ARE THERE TO HELP THEM."

KKK FLIERS LITTERED A ROWAN COUNTY NEIGHBORHOOD. ONE PERSON EVEN THREW ONE OF THE FLIERS AT A TEEN PLAYING BASKETBALL IN THE FRONT YARD. FOX 46'S ROBIN KANADY TALKS TO NEIGHBORS DEMANDING ANSWERS. THE RACIST FLIER SAYS "WAKE UP WHITE AMERICA! STOP ALLOWING THESE THIRD WORLD SAVAGES TO WALK ALL OVER YOUR PEOPLE. BLACKS ARE TAKING OVER YOUR TOWN AS YOU READ THIS. YOU ARE YOUR OWN WORST ENEMY IF YOU DO NOT JOIN US." "THIS IS RIDICULOUS, NO KIDDING." "WE WOULDN'T WANT TO HAVE OUR CHILDREN SEE THIS KIND OF TRASH." "COUNT THIS AS LITTERING AND PUT IT IN THE TRASH WHERE IT BELONGS." THE CAMERON GLEN NEIGHBORHOOD OFF SHERILLS FORD ROAD IN ROWAN COUNTY IS APPALLED AT WHAT SOME NEIGHBORS FOUND IN THEIR YARDS -THESE RACIST FLIERS WITH A LOGO OF THE "LOYAL WHITE KNIGHTS OF THE KKK". THERE WAS ALSO A SEPARATE FLIER WITH AN OFFENSIVE CARTOON. THE OTHER FLIER SAYS THINGS LIKE "BLACKS ARE SEVEN TIMES AS LIKELY AS PEOPLE OF OTHER RACES TO COMMIT MURDER." "THIS IS CRAZY - IT'S EVERYBODY'S CHOICE TO BE GOOD OR BAD, I DON'T UNDERSTAND THIS. I REALLY DON'T." A BLACK FAMILY GOT ONE OF THESE FLIERS AND THE WOMAN WHO REPORTED IT TO DEPUTIES TELLS ME HER 16-YEAR OLD NIECE WAS OUT PLAYING IN THE YARD WHEN SHE SAYS SHE SAW A PICK-UP TRUCK DRIVING BACK AND FORTH. SHE SAYS IT SUDDENLY STOPPED AND THE WOMAN SAYS THE MEN STARED HER NIECE DOWN AND THEN TOSSED ONE OF THE FLIERS AT HER, TRYING TO HIT HER WITH IT. THERE WERE ROCKS IN THE BAGS WITH THE FLIERS. "IF THERE WOULD HAVE BEEN PEOPLE HOME AT THE TIME, THE FOLKS WHO DID THIS PROBABLY WOULDN'T HAVE MADE IT OUT OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD UNSCATHED." THE ROWAN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE IS INVESTIGATING, TRYING TO TRACK DOWN THE PEOPLE WHO LITTERED THE NEIGHBORHOOD WITH HATEFUL MESSAGES. "NOBODY HAS ANY PATIENCE FOR THIS AROUND HERE."

BECAUSE OF SOMETHING THAT REALLY IS OUT OF THEIR CONTROL." FOOTBALL CAPTAIN PRINCE OKITUAMA HAS WITNESSED KIDS BEING TEASED. "IT KIND OF SADDENS ME. I FEEL LIKE EVERYBODY HAS A STORY. AS FOR LAUNDRY SUPPLIES, DONATIONS STARTED POURING IN ONCE THE WORD GOT OUT, AND NOT JUST FROM THE NEWARK COMMUNITY. "TEXAS, CALIFORNIA. WE ACTUALLY HAD SOMEONE CALL FROM CANADA AND ASK HOW THEY COULD DONATE." THE LAUNDRY ROOM WILL BE OPEN 5 DAYS A WK TO ANY STUDENT WHO WANTS TO USE IT AFTER SCHOOL. THIS IS EVIDENCE OF WEST SIDE HIGH'S COMMITMENT TO NO BULLYING, WHILE PERHAPS ALSO SERVING AS A LESSON IN HOME EC. "I'VE GOTTEN PULLED BACK THERE MULTIPLE TIMES BY KIDS. SO SOME OF THEM, THEY DON'T KNOW HOW TO WASH CLOTHES BECAUSE THEIR PARENTS HAVE BEEN TAKING CARE OF IT FOR THEM ALL OF THESE YEARS. SO THEY ARE LEARNING LIFE SKILLS IN ADDITION TO HAVING CLEAN CLOTHES. SO I THINK IT'S DEFINITELY HITTING MULTIPLE THINGS ALL AT ONCE AND THAT'S BEAUTIFUL."

THIS AREA USED TO BE A NEIGHBORHOOD, AND IT USED TO FLOOD A LOT. BUT THE COUNTY BOUGHT THE LAND FROM OWNERS AND TRANSFORMED IT INTO THIS PARK. IT'S A PROGRAM THEY OFFER TO PEOPLE WHO'S PROPERTY FREQUENTLY FLOODS. THE ULTIMATE GOAL IS TO REDUCE THIS: PEOPLE HAVING TO GET RESCUED FROM THEIR HOMES OR BUSINESSES WHEN THE MONSOONS HIT MECKLENBURG COUNTY. "IT'S OUR BUYOUT PROGRAM AND OVER THE LAST 20 YEARS, WE HAVE BOUGHT MORE THAN 400 PROPERTIES. PEOPLE CAN SELL THEIR LAND TO THE COUNTY, AND IN TURN, THE COUNTY WILL TRANSFORM IT INTO A PIECE OF PROPERTY THAT'S MEANT TO ABSORB SOME OF THE RAIN WATER. "THEIR INCENTIVE IS TO GET AWAY FROM THE DANGER, GET AWAY FROM THE FLOODING, AND SO GIVING THEM A REASONABLE PRICE, A FAIR MARKET PRICE FOR THE VALUE OF THE PROPERTY IS WHAT WE DO." HOGAN SAYS, "THAT IS A BIG ISSUE ACCORDING TO THE STUDY BY NORTHWESTERN, BUT THE REALITY IS THAT PEOPLE CAN DO THIS. WHEN PEOPLE GET ON A PLAN AND THEY START BUDGETING, THEY START SAVING AND THEY GET THEMSELVES OUT OF DEBT, THEN THEY'RE ABLE TO INVEST 15% OF THEIR INCOME FOR THEIR FUTURE. UNITED HEALTHCARE TOLD US THE FAMILY'S PLAN SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDES COVERAGE OF THE DEVICE, BUT KERN SAYS HIS EMPLOYER OFFERED NO PLANS THAT DID COVER IT.
