PEOPLE COULD RIDE BIKES, SKATEBOARD AND SIMPLY JUST WALK AROUND AND EXPLORE. USUALLY AROUND 30-THOUSAND PEOPLE TURN OUT TO TAKE PART IN THE EVENT.

PRIOR TO TODAY, THE FAMILY OFTEN HAD TO DRIVE IN 2 DIFFERENT CARS. AND AVONLEA IN A CAR SEAT THAT DIDN'T SUIT HER NEEDS. THE FAMILY REACHED OUT TO ALL THINGS POSSIBLE MEDICAL FUNDRAISING. IN 3 MONTHS THEY WERE ABLE TO RAISE THE MONEY, FIND A VAN WITH A RAMP FOR WHEN AVONLEA IS IN A WHEELCHAIR, AND DELIVER IT TO THE FAMILY. "IT'S ABSOLUTELY HUMBLING THAT ANYONE WOULD CARE TO LOVE US BY GIVING. IT JUST MEANS THE WORLD." LISA SEXTON, ALL THINGS POSSIBLE MEDICAL FUNDRAISING, "PEOPLE DON'T TYPICALLY HAVE 10-20 THOUSAND DOLLARS SITTING AROUND IN AN ACCOUNT FOR 'JUST IN CASE'. THAT'S WHY WE'RE HERE." AS VIOLET QUICKLY FIGURE OUT, THE VAN HAS ALL THE BELLS AND WHISTLES. AND WHILE AVONLEA CAN'T WALK, TALK OR STAND, HER SMILE TELLS IT ALL. "WE'RE JUST SO THANKFUL TO GOD EVERY DAY FOR THIS INCREDIBLE GIFT THAT HE'S GIVEN US. WE'VE LEARNED SO MUCH ABOUT LOVE AND WHAT IT MEANS TO LOVE. AND IT'S JUST BEEN AN AMAZING 4 YEARS AND THIS IS JUST THE BIGGEST BONUS TO AN ALREADY INCREDIBLE LIFE WE COULD'VE EVER ASKED FOR."

ADARA'S MOM HEATHER SAYS HELPING IS NOTHING NEW FOR HER DAUGHTER. A FEW YEARS AGO FOR HER BIRTHDAY SHE COLLECTED DONATIONS TO GIVE TO AN ANIMAL SHELTER. "WE LOVE IT. A NEW REPORT SAYS SOUTH CAROLINA REMAINS AMONG THE NATION'S DEADLIEST STATES FOR WOMEN. BASED ON 2016 HOMICIDE STATS, THE VIOLENCE POLICY CENTER SAYS 48 WOMEN WERE MURDERED BY MEN IN SOUTH CAROLINA IN 2016. THAT' ALMOST NEARLY TWO WOMEN KILLED PER 100,000 PEOPLE. SOUTH CAROLINA RANKS SIXTH NATIONALLY FOR ITS RATE OF WOMEN KILLED BY MEN. THE REPORT ALSO SAYS 95 PERCENT OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA WOMEN KNEW THEIR KILLERS. 69% WERE SLAIN BY CURRENT OR FORMER HUSBANDS OR BOYFRIENDS. DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH STARTS TODAY. IF YOU OR SOMEONE YOU KNOW NEEDS HELP, CALL THE NATIONAL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE HOTLINE.

THE YORK COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND CRIMESTOPPERS SENT OUT THE VIDEO, HOPING SOMEONE WILL RECOGNIZE THE SUSPECTED PORCH PIRATE. DEPUTIES SAY SHE LEFT THE FIELDSTONE NEIGHBORHOOD ON BRICKDUST COURT IN THIS DARK, 4-DOOR CAR. "I JUST THINK IT'S IMPORTANT FOR PEOPLE TO BE AWARE THAT THERE ARE PEOPLE WHO DO THINGS LIKE THAT, ESPECIALLY THIS TIME OF YEAR." MELANIE SAYS THE STOLEN PACKAGES HAD CLOTHES AND OTHER CHRISTMAS GIFTS FOR HER KIDS AND GRANDKIDS AND THE COMPANIES HAVE GRACIOUSLY AGREED TO REPLACE THE ITEMS. SHE STILL HOPES THE SUSPECTED PORCH PIRATE IS CAUGHT. AND, SHE MAY CHANGE HOW SHE SHOPS FROM NOW ON. "BE CAREFUL WITH ONLINE ORDERING. HAVE IT SHIPPED TO YOUR OFFICE OR SOMETHING LIKE THAT AND THAT'S PROBABLY WHAT I'LL DO."

TWO VICTIMS CLAIM THEIR "MATCH" SENT THEM NUDE PHOTOS, AND THEN THEY GOT A CALL FROM SOMEONE CLAIMING TO BE A DETECTIVE SAYING THERE'S A WARRANT OUT FOR THEIR ARREST FOR RECEIVING NUDE PHOTOS OF A JUVENILE. THEY THEN GET ANOTHER CALL FROM SOMEONE CLAIMING TO BE THE "DAD" OF THE JUVENILE SAYING IF HE'S PAID \$1200, THE WARRANT WILL GO AWAY. DEPUTIES SAY THIS IS A SCAM.

A STATESVILLE MAN HAS BEEN CHARGED FOR THREATENING A SCHOOL. DEPUTIES SAY 44-YEAR OLD BERNARD MILLER CALLED WEST IREDELL MIDDLE SCHOOL ABOUT A BULLYING INCIDENT. HE THREATENED TO BRING A GUN TO THE SCHOOL AND "HANDLE THE PROBLEM HIMSELF". MILLER WAS ARRESTED AND BOOKED AT THE IREDELL COUNTY JAIL.

IREDELL COUNTY DEPUTIES IDENTIFIED A WOMAN ACCUSED OF BREAKING INTO HOMES. AUTHORITIES SAY VICTORIA KISTLER AND THE MAN IN THIS PHOTO BROKE INTO TWO HOMES IN THE BRAWLEY SCHOOL ROAD AREA OF MOORESVILLE. THEY ISSUED ARREST WARRANTS FOR KISTLER FOR BREAKING AND ENTERING AND LARCENY. BUT THE MAN HAS YET TO BE FOUND.

IN THE MIDST OF ALL THE SCRAMBLING TO AVOID A GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN, LAWMAKERS DID MANAGE TO PASS LEGISLATION CALLED THE 'FIRST STEP ACT', ADDRESSING WHAT MANY ADVOCATES SEE AS BROKEN PARTS OF THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM. FOX'S ANNA ELIOPOULOS REPORTS ON IT'S IMPACT. PRESIDENT TRUMP SIGNS A SWEEPING REFORM BILL, IMPROVING PART OF THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM. THE BIPARTISAN MEASURE SAILED THROUGH CONGRESS GIVING THE PRESIDENT AND BOTH PARTIES A MAJOR VICTORY, AMID A TURBULENT WEEK OF DC POLITICS. TRUMP SAYS, "I WANT TO THANK EVERYBODY. THIS WAS INCREDIBLE, BIPARTISON SUPPORT. IN THE HOUSE WE PASSED IT 358-36 AND YOU LOOK AT THIS VOTE, YOU DON'T HAVE VOTES LIKE THAT." IN THE COURTROOM, JUDGES WILL NOW HAVE MORE OPTIONS WHEN SENTENCING DRUG AND LOW-LEVEL OFFENDERS. IT'S EXPECTED TO LEAD TO MORE LENIENCY, MEANING SHORTER PRISON SENTENCES, AND LESS PEOPLE RECEIVING HARSH MINIMUM SENTENCES. ONE GOAL IS TO ADDRESS AMERICA'S PROBLEM OF OVERCROWDING IN PRISONS. BUT IT'S ALSO ABOUT RECOGNIZING THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A POTENTIAL CAREER CRIMINAL AND SOMEONE WHO SHOWED A LAPSE IN JUDGMENT. "HE OFTEN USED THE 'N' WORD AROUND ME AND EVERYBODY HE WAS AROUND." AN EX WIFE SENT US THESE TEXT MESSAGES FROM LAST YEAR. THEY SHOW THE TSA MANAGER USED A SHORTENED FORM OF THE N-WORD TO DESCRIBE AN AFRICAN AMERICAN MALE. HE SAYS IT WAS A TYPO, AND TELLS FOX 46 THERE IS A "PERSONAL VENDETTA" AGAINST HIM. NOT SO, ACCORDING TO THREE FORMER FEDERAL AIR MARSHALS WHO SAY THAT TSA EMPLOYEE INSTRUCTED THEM TO TARGET AFRICAN AMERICANS WHEN THEY WORKED AT THE ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT A DECADE AGO. "HE TOLD US TO STOP AND TALK TO THE BLACK PEOPLE BECAUSE THEY'RE THE ONES THAT HAVE WARRANTS. BUT HE DIDN'T USE 'BLACK PEOPLE', HE USED THE N-WORD." "YOU BOTH HEARD HIM USE THE N-WORD?" "YES." "YES." AFTER OUR INVESTIGATION AIRED AT LEAST FOUR MEMBERS OF CONGRESS AND THE NAACP CALLED FOR AN IMMEDIATE INVESTIGATION. SHOULD THESE ALLEGATIONS PROVE TRUE, THIS GENTLEMAN NEEDS TO BE FIRED AND THERE NEEDS TO BE A TOP DOWN SHAKEUP. NOW THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY OFFICE OF INSPECTOR GENERAL CONFIRMS IT IS INVESTIGATING WHETHER THE TSA HAD ADEQUATE POLICIES IN PLACE TO PREVENT RACIAL DISCRIMINATION WHEN SCREENING PASSENGERS. PEOPLE USING THE ROADS HERE AS A THROUGHWAY WITH NOTHING TO SLOW THEM DOWN. CHRISTINE STEPHENSON AND HER HUSBAND RANDOLPH HAVE LIVED HERE FOR THE PAST FEW YEARS AND SAY THEY NEED A CHANGE ON THE ROAD. "IT WOULD BE NICE TO HAVE SPEED BUMPS, BECAUSE YOU COULD HAVE A PERSON CROSSING THE STREET, OR A CHILD." THEY MAY NOW BE ABLE TO GET THEIR WISH. AT MONDAY NIGHT'S CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL MEETING, ONE ITEM ON THE AGENDA WAS CALMING - WAYS TO MAKE IT EASIER FOR PEOPLE WHO HAVE TO DEAL WITH A LOT OF TRAFFIC, TO GET ANYTHING FROM SPEED BUMPS TO MULTI-WAY STOPS.
