The license of KTUZ-FM has determined the following issues are of importance to the community:

1. Interview with Carla Ponce with OU Health Stephenson Cancer Center

April 4, 2023

Carla shared information about the event “Lung Cancer Education and Prevention” held on April 6th. The event is completely free and open to the community. Educational resources and free health screenings will also be provided. Health screenings for cholesterol, glucose levels, and blood pressure. In addition, flu vaccines will be administered. The mission of the event is to educate assistants about lung cancer symptoms and prevention.

2. Interview with Carmen Romo with Integris Health

April 27, 2023

Carmen talked about the Integris Hispanic Health Fair held on April 29th from 9am-12pm. During the health fair, information resources, and free health screenings (e.g., glucose levels, cholesterol, BMI, and blood pressure) were provided. Additionally, vision exams, glaucoma tests, HIV tests, oral cancer screening, mammograms and more were offered at no cost.

3. Interview with Marc Salas with the Latino Community Development Agency

May 17, 2023

Marc provided information and invited the community to the Latino Community Development Agency Health Fair held on May 20th from 8am-12pm. The free services offered at the health fair were cholesterol, glucose, blood pressure, and body mass index exams. In addition, school required vaccines for children under 18 years of age were provided. He mentioned COVID-19

vaccines, cooking demonstrations, physical activities, and valuable resources would be offered.

4. Interview with Carla Ponce with OU Health Stephenson Cancer Center

June 1, 2023

Carla talked about the 2023 Men's Health Awareness Summit held on Saturday June 3rd from 9am-12pm. During the event information and resources will be provided to men interested in being proactive and open to learning more about the challenges of detecting and treating prostate cancer. Expert speakers and prostate cancer survivors will be present and share valuable information. In addition, free screenings for prostate cancer, colon cancer, and oral cancer will be offered. Other health screenings for glucose levels, blood pressure, and mental health resources will be available.

5. Interview with Carla Ponce with OU Health Stephenson Cancer Center

June 7, 2023

Carla invited the community to attend the event "Pancreas and Kidney Cancer Education and Prevention" held on June 8th from 6pm-8pm. Moreover, there will be health screenings for blood pressure, glucose levels, and cholesterol at no cost from 4pm-6pm. Flu vaccines and other health resources will be available. The purpose of the event is to educate the community about pancreas and kidney symptoms so that they can be aware and seek health screenings if required for early detection and prevention.
