1. Interview with Carla Ponce with OU Stephenson Cancer Center October 18, 2023

4. Interview with Benjamin Canizales with the Latino Community Development Agency

December 13, 2023

Benjamin talked about the last vaccination event held on December 14th presented by the LCDA and Oklahoma Care Foundation. All the vaccines required by the schools and CDC for 18 years old and under will be provided completely free. He also mentioned on every third Thursday of the month in addition to vaccines free health exams are offered. The free health screenings include glucose, cholesterol, blood pressure, and more.
