**1. Interview with Carmen with Latino Community Development Agency  
July 5, 2023**

Carmen talked about the vaccination clinic for kids held on July 6, 2023, from 9am to 12:30pm. Free vaccines for children and teenagers 0-19 years old. All vaccines required by school districts. Additional services and resources will also be offered to the community at no cost by The Oklahoma Caring Foundation, Inc.
