1. Interview with Carla Ponce with OU Health Stephenson Cancer Center

October 12, 2022

Carla talked about an event open to the community to be held on October 20, 2022, from 4pm to 8pm. During the event important information about breast cancer prevention will be shared. In addition, at the beginning of the event free health screening will be provided. The purpose of the event is to create awareness about breast cancer among Hispanic women and to provide education on early detection and genetic testing.

2. Interview with Carmen Vivenes with Latino Community Development Agency

November 16, 2022

Carmen talked about the rising numbers of individuals who have tested positive for the flu in Oklahoma. She mentioned a vaccination event open to the public being held on November 17, 2022, from 9am to 12:30pm at the Latino Agency. Flu and COVID-19 vaccines will be administered. Plus, free health screenings for levels of glucose, cholesterol, diabetes blood pressure and more will be offered.

3. Interview with Carla Ponce with OU Health Stephenson Cancer Center

December 6, 2022

Carla talked about a community event held on December 8, 2022, from 4pm-8pm. The purpose of the event is to provide information about early detection of colon cancer and prostate cancer. Other cancers such as throat

cancer and neck cancer were also briefly discussed. Further, free health screenings were provided and colon cancer screenings (e.g., bloodwork) is offered to those who meet the age requirement.
