1. Interview with Carla Ponce with OKC County Health Department April 7, 2021

Carla provided an important update on the COVID-19 vaccination clinics being held by the OKC County Health Department. She went over the new guidelines and who qualifies for the vaccine. She also mentioned the importance of registering for the vaccination events. She talked about a vaccination clinic held at US Grant High School on April 10th.

2. Interview with Carmen Romo with Integris and LCDA April 14, 2021

Carmen talked about a mobile COVID-19 vaccine clinic held at the Latino Development Agency on April 15, 2021 from 9am to 12pm. She stated any one interested in getting vaccinated must be 18 years or older and must schedule an appointment. She went over the vaccination process and answered questions in general about the vaccine.

3. Interview with Evelyn Cardona, Oklahoma Caring Foundation May 30, 2021

Evelyn talked about the regular children's vaccination events that will be held throughout the month of June. These vaccination clinics are open to the public. She mentioned the parent or legal guardian must accompany all children. They must also take the current shot record. She provided a phone number for any additional information.

4. Interview with Carla Ponce with OKC County Health Department June 25, 2021

Carla informed our audience about the progress that's being made with the COVID-19 vaccination clinics that have been offered at different locations as an effort to vaccinate more people. She also shared some of the percentages that reflect the number of vaccinated individuals in the community. She talked about the upcoming vaccination event on June 26th. She said there's still quite some work to do in order to keep the virus from spreading. She encouraged people to keep practicing protective measures against the virus.
