WQYZ provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- Domestic Violence: Gulf Coast Center for Nonviolence—Our own Kelly Bennett and Walter Brown participated in several events for the GCCNV in the month of April, including the "Walk a Mile In Her Shoes" event at Lighthouse Park in Biloxi the morning of April 12th. The walk was designed to bring attention to victims of domestic violence/rape...some end up at the shelter.
- Military/Community: The "Thunder Over the Sound: Keesler and Biloxi Air and Space Show set for May 4 and 5th both on Keesler Air Force Base and along the beaches in Biloxi was a huge event for us this quarter. Keesler Public Affairs Officer Sarah Loicano came in for frequent onair updates, we ran PSA's, AND NewsTalk 104.9 carried the live audio during the Thunderbirds portion of the show!
- Public Health/Safety: It hasn't been a good year for coast beaches. First, the Army Corps of Engineers opened up the Bonnet' Carre Spillway to relieve record flooding in north Mississippi...and weeks later there was a slew of beach closings due to a toxic algae bloom. We kept listeners up to speed with updates in our morning newscasts, as well as updates with guests on "Gulf Coast Issues"
