- Our stations are heavily involved in fundraising and public awareness campaigns for Breast Cancer Awareness Month in October. We begin early, with our News Director helping to emcee a breakfast where fundraising efforts for The American Cancer Society begin. Folks at the breakfast learn how they can spearhead a team to participate in upcoming Relay for Life Events, as well as the Making Strides Against Breast Cancer Walk on the Biloxi Town Green in October.
- Habitat for Humanity of the MS Gulf Coast is having their biggest fundraiser of the year in October. We ran PSA's, did interviews on our community affairs program, and created a link to the fundraiser on our station websites.

This quarter, we paid particular attention to plans for a Center of Hope, the latest plan from the Salvation Army MS Gulf Coast to help the less fortunate in our area.
