WQYZ provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- Childhood Cancer: Our stations teamed up with local businesses for the St. Jude Boot Drive campaign. Store patrons could make a donation to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, and give the "boot" to childhood cancer. This public service campaign, coupled with our St. Jude Radiothon Dec 5 and 6th helped raise \$290,250!
- Community: We teamed up with the city of Ocean Springs to promote one of their biggest events of the year, The Peter Anderson Festival. The Peter Anderson Arts & Crafts Festival was created to honor master potter, Peter Anderson, original potter of Shearwater Pottery, founded in 1928, and to celebrate the arts community. The festival aids in the economic development and growth of what has become Ocean Springs today. It takes place in November (Nov 2 and 3<sup>rd</sup> this year) each year, and draws people from all over country. We not only promoted the event through public service announcements and interviews in our local news, we were also on site to keep folks in the loop on where to park and how to get through traffic.
- Homelessness/Hunger: Morgan Shiyou with the local Salvation Army kept us abreast of not only their Christmas programs, but also all the worthwhile programs that help those in need along our coast all year round. We featured interviews with Morgan on our local newscasts.
