COMMUNITY

1. CENSUS DOOR KNOCKING. Aired 5/3/10 on KWGN.

PEOPLE WHO HAVEN'T TURNED IN THEIR CENSUS FORMS MAY SOON BE GETTING A VISIT FROM A CENSUS WORKER. THEY'RE GOING DOOR-TO-DOOR ASKING BASIC QUESTIONS ABOUT HOW MANY PEOPLE LIVE IN THE HOME ... AND HOW OLD THEY ARE. THE INFORMATION WILL HELP DETERMINE HOW MUCH STATE AND FEDERAL MONEY SCHOOLS ... HOSPITALS AND OTHER SERVICES WILL GET IN THE COMING YEARS. BUT CROOKS ARE ALSO HOPING TO CASH IN ON THIS DOOR-TO-DOOR SURVEY. ENVIRONMENT

1. BP OIL SPILL. Aired numerous times on KWGN since 4/20/10.

ONE-HUNDRED-MILLION DOLLARS A DAY AND COUNTING.... THAT'S HOW MUCH B-P SAYS THE RESPONSE EFFORT IN THE GULF IS COSTING THE OIL COMPANY, ACCORDING TO A S-E-C FILING SUBMITTED. OIL COMPANY OFFICIALS ALSO SAY THE *TOTAL* COST OF THE SPILL HAS REACHED *TWO-POINT-SIX-FIVE BILLION (\$2.65 BILLION)* DOLLARS. NAPOLITANO says: "we will not stop until the leak is plugged, the oil is cleaned and the claims are paid." B-P SAYS IT HAS RECEIVED MORE THAN *EIGHTY-THOUSAND (80,000)* CLAIMS AND MADE ALMOST *FORTY-ONE-THOUSAND (41,000)* PAYMENTS...TOTALING MORE THAN *ONE-HUNDRED-TWENTY-EIGHT MILLION (\$128 MILLION)* DOLLARS. B-P HAS LOST MORE THAN *ONE-HUNDRED-BILLION DOLLARS* IN MARKET VALUE SINCE THE INCIDENT BEGAN BACK ON APRIL TWENTIETH. THE RIG DRILLING THE RELIEF WELL THAT IS

EXPECTED TO STOP THE LEAK IS WITHIN TWENTY-FEET *HORIZONTALLY* OF THE BUSTED WELL....BUT THE RIG IS GOING TO DRILL AN ADDITIONAL *NINE-HUNDRED FEET (900)* BEFORE CREWS CUT IN SIDWAYS.... AND START PUMPING IN HEAVY MUD TO STOP THE FLOW. B-P SAYS THEY ARE MOVING WITH EXTREME CAUTION, TO MAKE SURE EVERYTHING IS LINED UP CORRECTLY BEFORE MAKING THAT FINAL PUSH. B-P FIGHTING THE SPILL FROM THE AIR TOO...WORKERS HUNTING MASSIVE SLICKS TO DROP DISPERSMENTS ON THE THEM IN ORDER TO BREAK UP THE OIL. MEANTIME, EVERYONE IN THE GULF IS KEEPING A CLOSE EYE ON TROPICAL STORM ALEX. ALTHOUGH IT IS NOT EXPECTED TO COME CLOSE TO THE SPILL SIGHT, IT COULD GENERATE WAVES UP TO FIFTEEN FEET HIGH...AND TWENTY-TO -THIRTY MILES-PER-HOUR WINDS ON ITS OUTER EDGES.

2. GULF OILSPILL WILDLIFE. Aired 6/1/10 on KWGN.

WILDLIFE OFFICIALS ON THE PANHANDLE OF FLORIDA ARE URGING PEOPLE ON THE BEACH TO HELP THEM HELP THE ANIMALS THAT HAVE BEEN EFFECTED BY THE GULF COAST OIL SPILL. A HOTLINE HAS BEEN SET UP SO THE PUBLIC CAN CALL WHEN THEY COME ACROSS BEACHED WILDLIFE. WORKERS FROM THE STATE'S FISH AND GAME DEPARTMENT ARE WALKING THE BEACHES LOOKING FOR ANY KIND OF OIL COVERED ANIMAL... FROM BIRDS TO TURTLES. THEY ARE ARMED WITH EVERYTHING TO FROM TOWELS TO PAPER BAGS TO HELP REMOVE THE SLUDGE.

FAMILY/CHILDREN

1. KIDS SAFETY ID KITS. Aired 5/25/10 on KWGN.

VERY DAY IN COLORADO AN AVERAGE OF *32* CHILDREN ARE REPORTED MISSING..MANY OF THOSE CHILDREN RETURN WITHOUT INCIDENT...BUT, IN SOME CASES... THEY'VE BEEN TAKEN.. WHETHER BY A NON-CUSTODIAL PARENT... OR BY A STRANGER. IN THOSE CASES... IT'S GOOD FOR PARENTS TO HAVE ALL THE INFORMATION ABOUT THEIR CHILD ON HAND... TO QUICKLY GIVE TO LAW ENFORCEMENT. TODAY IS NATIONAL MISSING CHILDREN'S DAY.. AND WE'RE OUT HERE AT PARK MEADOWS MALL... INVITING PARENTS TO COME DOWN AND GET THEIR *FREE* CHILD I-D KIT.

2.DADS EMPOWER KIDS TO TAKE CHANCES. Aired 6/21/10 on KWGN/KDVR.

A NEW STUDY FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA SHOWS THAT FATHERS ARE PUSHING THEIR CHILDREN TO TAKE RISKS. A PROFESSOR FROM THE CURRY SCHOOL SAYS FATHERS TEND TO BE MORE SUPPORTIVE IN PLAY, ALLOWING CHILDREN TO TAKE THE LEAD. MOTHERS ON THE OTHER HAND, TEND TO DEVELOP A MORE EMPATHATHETIC AND EMOTIONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH THEIR CHILDREN. MOTHERS ALSO HELP CHILDREN FEEL CONNECTED, ANTICIPATED AND WANTED....WHILE FATHERS TEACH THEM HOW TO INTERACT WITH OTHERS AND HOW TO CONTROL THEMSELVES.

GOVERNMENT

1. DPS \$8 MILLION GRANT. Aired 4/9/10 on KWGN.

DENVER PUBLIC SCHOOLS a getting A *HUGE* financial BOOST. DPS WILL GET MORE THAN 8-MILLION DOLLARS IN federal stimulus MONEY FROM THE GOVERNMENT... TO INVEST IN RECRUITING AND RETAINING *GREAT TEACHERS*. THE grant WILL BE USED TO BRING TEACHERS TO DENVER...AND to REIMBURSE THEM FOR EARNING THEIR MASTER'S DEGREES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF DENVER.

2. JOBLESS RATE RISES. Aired 5/7/10 on KWGN.

IT WAS A VOLATILE DAY ON WALL STREET WITH STOCK PRICES FLUCTUATING SHARPLY. IT'S A SIGN INVESTORS REMAINED NERVOUS ONE DAY AFTER AN UNPRECEDENTED SELLOFF THAT SENT STOCKS PLUMMETING NEARLY 1000 POINTS IN 30 MINUTES. THE PRESIDENT SAYS THE GOVERNMENT WILL TAKE STEPS TO PREVENT ANOTHER VIOLENT STOCK DROP. SURROUNDED BY HIS ECONOMIC TEAM, THE PRESIDENT REACTED TO WHAT HE SAYS IS A POSITIVE JOBS REPORT THAT SHOWS EMPLOYERS ADDED 290,000 JOBS IN APRIL - THE MOST IN FOUR YEARS. BUT THE UNEMPLOYMENT RATE UNEXPECTEDLY INCHED UP, FROM 9.7 TO 9.9%. THE PRESIDENT SAYS THE UPTICK REFLECTS PEOPLE'S OPTIMISM ABOUT EMPLOYMENT PROSPECTS AS THEY GET BACK ON THE JOB HUNT. CRITICS SAY IF THIS IS PROGRESS, IT'S PAINFULLY SLOW. THE WHITE HOUSE SAYS THE PRESIDENT IS ALSO BEING REGULARLY UPDATED ON THE SITUATION IN GREECE, WHERE PEOPLE ARE RIOTING AMID PANIC OVER THAT COUNTRY'S ECONOMIC PROBLEMS. THAT'S ADDING TO THE SKITTISHNESS ON WALL STREET, WHERE THERE'S CONCERN THE GREEK DEBT CRISIS COULD SPREAD.

HEALTH/WELFARE

1. NO SMOKING IN WHEAT RIDGE. Aired 5/17/10 on KWGN.

BEING OUTSIDE MAY NOT BE A FREE PASS ANY MORE IF YOU LIVE IN WHEAT RIDGE AND WANT TO LIGHT UP. THAT'S BECAUSE THE CITY IS CONSIDERING BANNING SMOKING OUTSIDE IN PUBLIC AREAS. THE CITY COUNCIL TOOK RECOMMENDATIONS FROM COMMUNITY AND MEDICAL GROUPS AS WELL AS THE JEFFERSON COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH. THE REPORTS FOUND THAT SECOND HAND SMOKE CAN BE DANGEROUS WITH-IN 10 FEET, EVEN IF IT IS OUT DOORS. THE NEW RULES WOULD BAN SMOKING IN BUS SHELTERS, AND RESTAURANT PATIOS AND EVEN AT PUBLIC PARKS AND GOLF COURSES. WE TALKED TO SEVERAL PEOPLE WHO BOTH AGREED AND DISAGREED WITH THE PROPOSAL.

HOUSING/HOMELESS

1. HIDDEN HOMELESS. Aired 5/19-20/10 on KWGN.

KIDS WITH NO PLACE TO SLEEP AT NIGHT...IT'S A GROWING PROBLEM FOR SCHOOL DISTRICTS ACROSS THE STATE. THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS WHO ARE HOMELESS HAS MORE THAN DOUBLED SINCE 2003. THERE ARE MORE THAN 2-THOUSAND STUDENTS WITHOUT HOMES IN JEFFERSON COUNTY.. ABOUT 24-HUNDRED IN ADAMS COUNTY...AND ALMOST 16-THOUSAND ACROSS THE STATE. KIM POSEY HAS THEIR STORY.

2. HOMELESS KIDS GRADUATION. Aired 5/20/10 on KWGN.

TWO GRADUATES RECEIVED SCHOLARSHIPS COURTESY OF COLLEGE INVEST. URBAN PEAK HELPS HOMELESS YOUTH AND YOUTH AT RISK OVERCOME REAL LIFE CHALLENGES BY PROVIDING ESSENTIAL SERVICES AND A SUPPORTIVE COMMUNITY.

PUBLIC SAFETY/CRIME

1. CRIME VICTIMS WEEK. Aired 4/18-19/10 on KWGN.

FOR THE PAST 29 YEARS, THE NATIONAL CRIME VICTIMS RIGHTS WEEK HAS BEEN OBSERVED ACROSS THE NATION. THE WEEK IS A TIME TO BUILD PUBLIC AWARENESS ABOUT THE CHALLENGES CRIME VICTIMS FACE. IT'S ALSO A TIME TO CELEBRATE PROGRESS MADE IN VICTIMS RIGHTS AND SERVICES. ONE MOTHER WHO LOST HER SON IN A TRAGIC SHOOTING AT A CLUB ON BROADWAY, IS USING THE WEEK TO KICK OFF A DIFFERENT KIND OF MEMORIAL. JON BOWMAN IS LIVE ON BROADWAY WHERE HER SON WAS KILLED.

2. GREELEY APARTMENT SAFETY PROGRAM OFFERED. Aired 6/24/10 on KWGN.

LANDLORDS AND THE CITY OF GREELEY ARE TEAMING UP TO HELP PREVENT CRIME AND KEEP PROPERTY SAFE. IT'S CALLED "OPERATION SAFE STAY". HERE'S HOW IT WORKS...LANDLORDS WHO SIGN UP AGREE TO TIGHTER TENANT SCREENING AND GET SPECIAL TRAINING FROM THE CITY RELATED TO SAFETY AND CRIME PREVENTION. TO REGISTER CALL THE CITY OF GREELEY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT AT (970) 350-9780 BY JUNE 28. THE NEXT TRAINING SESSION IS JUNE 30TH.

TRANSPORTATION

1. TARMAC DELAY RULE. Aired 4/27 on KWGN.

A NEW RULE DESIGNED TO PREVENT PLANES FROM SITTING ON THE TARMAC TOO LONG... WILL GO INTO EFFECT THIS WEEK. TODAY THE TRANSPORTATION SECRETARY IS EXPECTED TO DISCUSS THE NEW TARMAC DELAY RULE... SET TO TAKE EFFECT THURSDAY. IT IS DESIGNED TO PREVENT PLANES ON DOMESTIC ROUTES FROM SITTING ON THE TARMAC FOR MORE THAN THREE HOURS WITH PASSENGERS ON BOARD. AIRLINES WHO VIOLATE THE RULE COULD FACE FINES OF UP TO A 27-THOUSAND DOLLARS PER PASSENGER. OPPONENTS SAY AIRLINES ARE LIKELY TO CANCEL MORE FLIGHTS DURING BUSY TRAVEL SEASONS TO AVOID PENALTIES.

2. RTD FASTRACK TO DIA. Aired on 6/16/10 on KWGN.

IT'S THE TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM MANY IN DENVER HAVE BEEN ASKING FOR. COMMUTER LIGHT RAIL LINES TO D-I-A ARE NOW IN OFFICIAL OPERATION. THE *TWO-BILLION DOLLAR PROJECT WILL BUILD A LINE FROM UNION STATION IN DENVER TO THE AIRPORT. IT PLANS TO OPEN BY JANUARY 2016. ALSO IN THE CONTRACT... LINES WILL BE BUILT TO ARVADA AND SOUTH WESTMINSTER. WITH

THE NEW DECISION... 47-MILES OF NEW RAIL WILL BE UNDER CONSTRUCTION. THAT'S MORE THAN DOUBLE THE AMOUNT OF RTD'S EXISTING LIGHT RAIL SYSTEM.

Locally produced news product focusing on national and local news. Features traffic, weather and guest appearances.

2. DAYBREAK – 6A

Airs Mon-Fri/6-7am

Locally produced news product focusing on national and local news. Features traffic, weather and guest appearances.

3. DAYBREAK – 7A

Airs Mon-Fri/7-8am

Locally produced news product focusing on national and local news. Features traffic, weather and guest appearances.

4. DAYBREAK – 8A

Airs Mon-Fri/8-9am

Locally produced news product focusing on national and local news. Features traffic, weather and guest appearances.

5. EVERYDAY

Airs every Mon-Fri/10-11am

EVERYDAY is a weekly informational/entertainment talk show that is produced by KWGN-TV. The program features local guests from the arts to chefs to shop owners.

6. NEWS ON THE DEUCE – 7P

Airs Mon-Fri/7-8pm

Locally produced news product focusing on national and local news. Features traffic and weather, exposes, as well as undercover and consumer advocacy pieces.
