KYSR provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **Animal Adoption/Rescue:** Leave No Paws Behind; Provides hospice care, comfort, love and a safe haven for the terminally ill and the hard core cases and LNPB will never board a rescued animal.
- **Animal Rights :** I Stand With My Pack is a non-profit organization that aides in the prevention of animal suffering and cruelty through means of education, hands-on field work, fundraising, non-violent protest, legal action, and collaborative efforts with other organizations & governments.
- **Arts:** Making Movies That Matter (MMTM) is a Youth Short Film Festival open to all K-16 students within CD12 and the San Fernando Valley. The intent of MMTM is to inspire students to identify issues and topics that resonate with them and to have that passion manifest itself in films that touch people.
- **At-Risk Youth:** The Laurel Foundation has provided year round educational and support programs to at-risk children, youth, and families.
- **Cancer Awareness:** The funds raised from 2017 ZERO Prostate Cancer Run/Walk - Los Angeles/Long Beach are invested around the country to provide research for new treatments, free prostate cancer testing, and educate men and families about prostate cancer.
- **Child Abuse Prevention:** The Child Abuse Prevention Center is the County's leading not-for-profit organization focused exclusively on the prevention of child abuse.
- **Community:** Spoke with Aaron Valencia, Lost Angels Children's Project is a non-profit after school program that teaches foster, low income, and at risk youth classic car restoration/arts.
- **Disability Awareness:** Free Wheelchair Mission is a humanitarian, faith-based, nonprofit organization that provides wheelchairs at no cost to people with disabilities living in developing nations.

- **Education:** Comm Week 2017 will take place April 24-27, 2017. Nearly all events will be held on the main Fullerton campus, with some held at the Irvine Campus. Comm Week is a longstanding tradition at California State University, Fullerton and has been around for over 38 years.
- **Empowerment:** International Sanctuary is a nonprofit based out of Irvine. Their mission is to empower people rescued from trafficking to transform themselves into survivors by embracing their true identity and worth.
- **Environmental:** KIDS OCEAN DAY is the culmination of a year-round school assembly program by the Malibu Foundation for Environmental Education to teach school kids about how litter flows from our neighborhoods to the ocean, thereby killing marine life and polluting food resources.
- **Fostering:** United Friends of The Children develops long term relationships with the youth in its programs to help them overcome the obstacles they face to lead meaningful and independent adult lives. On June 8th United Friends of The Children will host their 14th Annual Brass Ring Awards Dinner.
- **Funding Cancer Research:** Concern Foundation is an independent, volunteer-driven organization conceived in 1968 by a group of friends who wanted to make sure their dollars counted in the fight against cancer.
- **Health & Wellness:** The Ruby Dooby Foundation is a foundation created by Ruby's Diner that is dedicated to the health and well being of children.
- **Homeless Support:** Shelter Partnership, Inc. is a nonprofit organization collaboratively solving homelessness in Los Angeles County through policy analysis, program design, resource development, and advocacy in support of agencies and local governments that serve the homeless.
- **Humanity:** The Vietnamese Culture Alliance (VACA) is pleased to announce that Courage to Rebuild, a public art project commemorating the 40th anniversary of Vietnamese immigration to the United States, will officially unveil at a public celebration on Saturday, May 20, 2017.
- **LGBTQ Support:** This year we're excited to announce OC Pride 2017 to be held on Saturday, June 24, 2017 in Downtown Santa Ana!
