

## Smoky Hill FCC filing

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, notice is hereby given that Smoky Hills Public Television is required to file with the FCC, no later than February 1st, 2006, an application for renewal of TV translator station K32BY, licensed to Oberlin, KS. Station K32BY operates with a peak transmitter power output of 1000 watts from a site 8 miles west of Oberlin, KS and transmits on Channel 32. K32BY rebroadcasting station KOOD, Channel 9 licensed to Hays, KS.

Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to station K32BY's renewal application and to whether this station has operated in the public interest should file comments and petitions with the FCC by May 1st, 2006.
