WCVF contains numerous programs that cater to community issues. They include:

• NPR (National Public Radio)

o Which is carried daily from 7-9am ("Morning Edition") and 4-6pm ("All Things Considered") Monday through Friday. NPR covers everything from international and national news to interviews and special topics. NPR covers any current event that may have an effect on our daily lives.

• High Noon Friday

o A completely student-produced live talk/variety show that airs every Friday at noon. It is one hour long and features a variety of segments such as comedy skits, news, sports, reviews, interviews with campus and community members, trivia shows, and more!

• The Local Lo-Down

o Every Wednesday 8-9pm WCVF airs "The Local Lo-Down". It is a live showcase of strictly local artists and performers with an emphasis on promoting upcoming events/concerts in the local community.

• Sabor Latino

o A community member show run by Harry Echevarria and his co-hosts weekly that cover and feature music for the local Hispanic community throughout their 2 hours time block from 6-8pm on Saturdays.

• Big Blue Sports Podcast

A sport based radio show that every Wednesday from 10-11am that covers
on-campus Fredonia clubs and local Buffalo team games. They also cover history

and background about the Buffalo & Fredonia sports clubs and theory impact on current sports.

• News at Noon

- News at Noon airs briefly every Monday and Wednesday at noon. This show highlights SUNY Fredonia campus news and events, local news, local music events, sports and weather. It also includes national and international news.
- When DJ's are live on the air, we require that they announce one grapevine file per hour. Grapevines are non-profit announcements about community events. They are time-sensitive and are announced manually by the DJ's.
