Description: Summary of some of the new state laws that become effective today.

- 1) Assembly Bill 44 allows more charging station areas for electric cars in low-income homes and neighborhoods. The goal to help keep the state on track for 50% clean energy by 2030.
- 2) AB 116 switches minor traffic tickets from criminal to civil. For example, a bench warrant would not be issued for not paying a basic ticket. Instead, the driver would be turned over to a bill collector.
- 3) AB 349 focuses on closing the "classic car" license plate loophole. Vehicles deemed "classic cars" are issued a "classic car" license plate which allows them to bypass the smog check. Classic cars are now required to have classic car insurance.
- 4) A new law involves tobacco purchases. A clerk could get a \$100 civil fine if they don't ask for I.D. for folks under 40 years old.
